NEW HAVEN, Conn. – After playing its opening three games in the friendly confines of Yale Bowl, Class of 1954 Field, Team 150 hits the road for the first time this Saturday. The Bulldogs travel North to face Dartmouth at Memorial Field. Kickoff is slated for 1:30 p.m. The game will be televised on NESN and streamed on ESPN+.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- The Bulldogs picked up their first victory of the season last Saturday, knocking off Morgan State 45-3 in the NAACP Harmony Classic. Quarterback Nolan Grooms threw for 363 yards and four touchdowns, and the defense limited Morgan State to just 204 yards of total offense. The Bulldogs led 17-3 at halftime and then outscored the Bears 28-0 in the third quarter.
- Grooms' 450 yards of total offense (363 passing, 87 rushing) tied for the fifth most in a single game in school history. His performance earned him the weekly Gold Helmet Award from the New England Football Writers Association and Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- Grooms is ninth all-time at Yale in completions (294) and passing attempts (510). Against Morgan State, his passing yards (363), completions (29) and attempts (38) were all career highs. In addition, his four touchdown passes matched his career high.
- Grooms leads the Ivy League and is sixth nationally in passing efficiency (164.2).
- Clay Patterson has recorded a sack in six straight games dating back to last season. He has three sacks on the season which is 12th in the nation, and his 21 career sacks are tied for the fourth most in school history.
- Receiver Mason Tipton is coming off a career day. His nine receptions, 136 receiving yards and two touchdown receptions were all career highs. His four touchdown receptions on the season leads the Ivy League and his 248 receiving yards is second.
- Receiver Ryan Lindley also set a career-high with nine receptions last week against Morgan State. He is ninth in the league in receptions per game (5.0).
- The Bulldogs are averaging 184.3 yards per game, which is second in the league and 24th in the nation.
- Yale hasn't won in Hanover since 2010 when Philippe Panico kicked a 19-yard field goal as time expired resulting in a 23-20 victory. The Bulldogs have lost five straight at Memorial Field and two of those losses spoiled perfect seasons – 42-10 in 2019 and 28-27 in 2017. Yale finished 9-1 in both of those years.

2023 YALE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

HISTORY LESSONS

Saturday's matchup is the 106th all-time meeting between Yale and Dartmouth. The Bulldogs lead the series 55-44-6. The first meeting came in 1884, a game the Elis won 113-0. Yale snapped a four-game losing streak to the Big Green last year at Yale Bowl, Class of 1954 Field, winning 24-21. Tre Peterson rushed for 173 yards and one touchdown. Hamilton Moore sealed the victory with an interception with 36 seconds left in the fourth quarter. The Bulldogs had a 24-7 lead after three quarters, but Dartmouth rallied.

SCOUTING DARTMOUTH

The Big Green (2-1, 1-0 Ivy) is coming off a thrilling 23-20 overtime victory at Penn last Saturday. Owen Zalc's 37-yard field goal in overtime was the game-winner. Zalc booted three field goals on the afternoon and was named the Ivy League Rookie of the Week for the second straight week. Penn's Albert Jang booted a 51-yard field with less than a minute to play to force overtime. Dartmouth Quarterback Nick Howard both ran and passed for a touchdown. The Big Green is 12th in the nation in total defense, yielding just 278.3 yards per game. Dartmouth opened the season with a 24-7 loss to New Hampshire but has won its last two, including a 34-17 win over Lehigh on Sept. 23.

OWENS NAMED CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

Wande Owens, the captain of Team 150, has been selected as a semifinalist for the 2023 William V. Campbell Trophy®, college football's premier scholar-athlete award. Celebrating its 34th year, the Campbell Trophy® recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership.

Owens, of Cooksville, Md., has excelled on the field, in the classroom and in the community during his time at Yale. He is a two-time All-Ivy selection, including earning first team recognition last fall after tying for the team lead with 63 tackles. He also was named to the New England Football Writers Association All-New England team.

At Yale, Owens, a computer science major, has served as President of the Zeta Psi Fraternity, Eta Chapter and been a volunteer with Team Impact. In the summers of 2022 and 2021, he interned at GoDaddy, where he developed a front-end web application using JavaScript and created CI/CD pipeline leveraging AWS, Kubernetes, Helm and Docker.

During the pandemic, Owens was a Medical Assistant at First Call Urgent Care in Clarksville, Md., where he registered patients for Covid-19 testing. He also served as a courier for the Centennial Medical Group in Maryland, delivering Covid-19 tests from a testing site to a lab.

The NFF will announce 12-14 finalists on Oct. 25, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the 2023 NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class Presented by Fidelity Investments. The finalists will travel to the ARIA Resort & Casino in Las Vegas for the 65th NFF Annual Awards Dinner Presented by Las Vegas on Dec. 5, where their accomplishments will be highlighted in front of one of the most powerful audiences in all of sports.

AMEGADJIE EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

Offensive lineman Kiran Amegadjie garnered a slew of preseason accolades. The most recent came when he was named to the 2024 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List. The Reese's Senior Bowl is widely regarded as the preeminent college football all-star game and the first stage in the NFL Draft process. The longest continual-running all-star game has taken place in Mobile, Ala., the past 74 years. More than 900 NFL personnel, including key decision-makers from all 32 teams, and over 1,100 media members from around the country were credentialed last year.

Amegadjie also was named a preseason All-American by Stats Perform and analyst Phil Steele. Steele also selected him as the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year.

Last fall, Amegadjie earned first team All-Ivy recognition after starting all 10 games and helping anchor a line that allowed Yale to lead the league in rushing and total offense. In his first season in 2021, he earned honorable mention All-Ivy recognition and received the team's Charles Loftus Award as the most valuable first year player.

GROOMS NAMED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

Quarterback Nolan Grooms will begin the 2023 season in contention for one of the most prestigious awards in all of FCS football. Grooms has been named to the preseason watch list for the 2023 Walter Payton Award, presented by FedEx Ground and given annually to the national offensive player of the year in Division I FCS college football.

Grooms is coming off an outstanding 2022 season that saw him win the Asa S. Bushnell Cup as the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year. He also earned first team All-Ivy recognition after excelling both with his feet and his arm in helping lead the Bulldogs to an outright Ivy League championship. Grooms finished second in the league in rushing with 726 yards while also throwing for 1,660 yards. He accounted for 20 total touchdowns with 14 through the air and six by way of the ground. His top rushing performance came against Princeton when he carried 20 times for 152 yards and his top passing game came against Columbia when he threw for 346 yards and four touchdowns.

YALE 7TH ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COLLEGE PROGRAM

The Bulldogs begin the 2023 season with 929 all-time victories, the seventh most in all of NCAA college football. Michigan (989 wins) began the season as the all-time winningest program, followed by Alabama and Ohio State (953), Notre Dame (938), Texas (936) and Oklahoma (934).

YALE PRESEASON FAVORITE IN IVY LEAGUE

Team 150 will begin the 2023 season as the favorite in the race for the Ivy League title. The league released its official preseason poll in mid-August, and the Bulldogs were picked to finish first, receiving 13 first-place votes and 122 points. There were 16 voters (two media representatives that cover each school).

Princeton, which received one first-place vote and had 103 points, is projected to finish second followed by Penn (90), Harvard (one first-place vote, 84), Columbia (one first-place vote, 62), Dartmouth (54), Cornell (37) and Brown (24).

NFL CONNECTION

Bulldogs continue to make their marks in the NFL. Foyesade Oluokun '18 is back with the Jacksonville Jaguars after leading the league in tackles in each of the last two seasons, Rodney Thomas II '22 is in his second season with the Indianapolis Colts and Dieter Eiselen '19 recently signed with the Houston Texans. In addition, Mike McDaniel '05 is in his second season as the head coach of the Miami Dolphins.

TONY RENO

Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach

- Named the Joel E. Smilow '54 Head Coach of Yale Football on Jan. 12, 2012. In his 11th season at the helm in 2023.
- Guided the Bulldogs to Ivy League championships in three of the last five seasons (2022, 2019 and 2017).
- Enters the 2023 season with 60 victories, which is tied for the fifth most in school history.
- Four Bulldogs have won the Asa S. Bushnell Cup as the Ivy Player of the Year under Reno's direction – quarterback Nolan Grooms (2022), quarterback Kurt Rawlings (2019), linebacker Matthew Oplinger (2017) and running back Tyler Varga (2014). Running back Joshua Pitsenberger (2022), quarterback Griffin O'Connor (2018) and running back Zane Dudek (2017) have been named Ivy Rookie of the Year during his tenure.
- Seven Bulldogs Reno has coached have gone on to play in the National Football League – Dieter Eiselen (Chicago Bears), Jaeden Graham (Atlanta Falcons, Philadelphia Eagles), JJ Howland (Tampa Bay Buccaneers), Foyesade Oluokun (Atlanta Falcons, Jacksonville Jaguars), Matthew Oplinger (Arizona Cardinals), Rodney Thomas II (Indianapolis Colts) and Tyler Varga (Indianapolis Colts). Oluokun, who led the NFL in tackles in 2021 and 2022, Thomas and Eiselen are currently on NFL rosters.
- Selected as the Ivy League Coach of the Year in 2022 after leading Team 149 to an outright Ivy title with an 8-2 overall record and a 6-1 league mark. The Bulldogs led the league in scoring offense (30.5 ppg.) and were second in scoring defense (19.5 ppg.).
- In 2019, led Team 147 to a 9-1 season that was capped with a thrilling 50-43, double overtime victory over Harvard in The Game. The Bulldogs trailed by 19 points early in the fourth quarter but scored two touchdowns in the final 90 seconds to force overtime before finishing off the remarkable comeback as darkness set in at Yale Bowl.
- In 2017, guided the Bulldogs to their first outright Ivy title in 37 years. Team 145, which included 20 all-league selections, finished with a No. 24 national ranking after earning the Blue's first Ivy championship in 11 seasons. The championship was clinched in grand fashion with a 24-3 win over Harvard before 52,000 fans at Yale Bowl. Following the memorable season, Reno earned Division I Coach of the Year honors from both the New England Football Writers and the Gridiron Club of Boston.
- Selected as a finalist for the 2014 Eddie Robinson Award, presented annually to college football's top head coach in the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision. The Bulldogs finished with an 8-2 overall record that season, including a thrilling overtime victory over FBS Army at Yale Bowl, which was celebrating its 100th anniversary. Yale was in the hunt for the Ivy title entering The Game, which brought the ESPN GameDay crew to Harvard Stadium.



- Spent six years on the Yale coaching staff under Jack Siedlecki, rising to assistant head coach. Helped the Bulldogs win the 2006 Ivy title as the defensive secondary coach after coaching wide receivers in 2003. Fourteen of his players earned all-league honors during his tenure as a Yale assistant coach.
- Prior to being named Yale's head coach, served as Harvard's special teams coordinator and defensive secondary coach from 2009 to 2011. Helped engineer an undefeated 2011 Ivy League championship team for the Crimson, which earned a No. 14 FCS national ranking.
- Oxford, Mass., native and a 1997 Worcester State College graduate. Completed a master's of science in health education from Worcester State in 2000.
- As a player at Worcester State, was a three-year starter at free safety, and his team was league champion his last two seasons.
- Served as Worcester State's defensive coordinator from 1998 to 2002 and was the 2002 AFLAC/Coach Magazine National Assistant of the Year Award winner. The Lancers, who made two post-season appearances and went 27-5 with Reno as defensive coordinator, were 2001 ECAC Northeast Champions and made it to the title game the following year.
- The first Yale football head coach from Massachusetts since Ted Coy '10 in 1910.
- Reno and his wife, Toni, have three children: Dante, Angelina and Vince.


