## WEEKEND PREVIEW

- The Youngstown State baseball team (0-6) will begin a three-game non-conference series at Louisville (4-4) on Friday at 3 p.m. at Jim Patterson Stadium in Louisville, Ky. The Penguins and Cardinals will proceed to play on Saturday at 1 p.m. before closing the series on Sunday at 1 p.m.
- Friday's series opener will mark the first meeting on the diamond between YSU and Louisville since 2018. All three games of the series will be broadcast live on ACC Network Extra and YSNLive.com while live stats will be available through links on YSUsports.com. Fans can also follow @YSUBaseball on X for live updates.
- Junior right-hander and Ohio State transfer Jacob Gehring will take the mound in the series opener on Friday while sophomore left-hander Sloan Ulrich is set start game two of the series on Saturday. Sophomore left-hander Braden Gebhardt is scheduled to take the ball in the series finale on Sunday.
- Redshirt senior shortstop Trey Law and sophomore infielder Matt Thompson were each named to Perfect Game's Horizon League Preseason All-Conference Team in the website's 2024 conference preview.
- Law was named to the All-Horizon League Second Team and the ABCA/Rawlings East All-Region Second Team last season after batting .362 and slugging .452 with 80 hits, 17 doubles, one home run and 29 RBIs. He also recorded 50 runs scored, 24 walks, 100 total bases, a .437 on-base percentage and 10 stolen bases while starting 52 games at shortstop.
- Thompson, who was named the 2023 Horizon League Freshman of the Year, batted .316 and slugged .439 with 54 hits, 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs and 28 RBIs while playing in 47 games and making 46 starts at second base during his debut collegiate campaign.
- Six different Penguins were listed among Perfect Game's Top MLB Draft Prospects in the Horizon League. Gehring was ranked the league's No. 9 prospect for the 2024 MLB Draft. He was joined on the website's top-25 prospects for 2024 by Law (No. 21), senior outfielder RJ Sherwood (No. 23) and junior catcher Ian Francis (No. 25). Thompson was listed as Perfect Game's top 2025 prospect while freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was ranked as the league's No. 2 prospect for 2026.
- Freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was selected as the Preseason Horizon League Freshman of the Year by D1Baseball.com in the website's 2024 conference preview. The Brownsville, Pa., native was drafted by the Oakland Athletics with the 526th overall pick in the 18th round of the 2023 Major League Baseball Draft.
- Youngstown State was picked fifth in the 2024 Horizon League Baseball Preseason Poll after a vote of the league's head coaches. The Penguins were picked to finish fourth in the Horizon League by D1Baseball.com.

## QUICK NOTES

- The Penguins posted an overall record of 19-36 with a 13-16 mark in Horizon League play in 2023. Dan Bertolini has now guided the program to double-digit Horizon League wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. With 10 road victories in 2023, Youngstown State has also recorded double-digit road wins in three straight seasons for the first time since 2005-07.
- The 2023 campaign was highlighted by YSU's longest winning streak in 18 years. YSU won eight straight games from April 25 to May 9 to put together its longest winning streak since 2005. The Penguins won 12 of their final 16 games while earning four consecutive Horizon League series victories to close out the 2023 regular season.
- Youngstown State set a new single-season school record with 123 doubles as a team in 2023. The previous record of 115 was set in 2010. YSU also set a new single-season school record with 190 extra-base hits in 2023, surpassing the previous mark of 183 that was also set in 2010.
- YSU's 54 home runs as a team in 2023 rank as the second most in a season in program history behind the school record of 60 that was set in 2010. The 2023 season marks just the fourth time in school history that the Penguins have hit at least 50 home runs – three of those occurrences have come during Bertolini's tenure as head coach. The 2023 season also marks the only campaign in YSU history that four different players hit at least eight homers.
- With two wins at Baylor in early March and a victory at Pitt on April 10 in 2023, YSU has now earned five victories against Power Five opponents over the past two campaigns. YSU has collected nine Power Five victories over Bertolini's first seven seasons as head coach. YSU's 7-5 victory at Baylor on March 3, 2023, marked the program's first win over a Big 12 opponent since 2013.

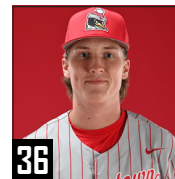

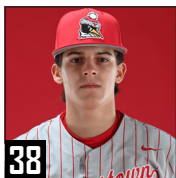

## YSU AT LOUISVILLE

### A Win on Friday Would...

- Give YSU its first victory of the 2024 season.
- Improve YSU's record to 1-6.
- Give the Penguins their first win against the Cardinals in four all-time meetings.
- Give the Penguins their sixth win over a Power Five opponent in the last three seasons.
- Give YSU its 10th victory over a Power Five opponent and seventh win over an ACC opponent during Dan Bertolini's tenure.
- Be the 355th in head coach Dan Bertolini's career and his 126th at Youngstown State.

### Scouting The Cardinals

- Louisville enters the weekend on a four-game winning streak at 4-4 overall after a 12-3 home victory over Eastern Kentucky on Tuesday. Of their four losses, the Cardinals have dropped three one-run decisions.
- Senior outfielder JT Benson is batting .550 and slugging .800 with 11 hits and eight RBIs over seven games played. Freshman outfielder Lucas Moore is batting .440 and slugging .520 while leading the team with seven stolen bases and 13 runs scored over eight games and seven starts.
- Senior left-hander and Wright State transfer Sebastian Gongora owns a 4.09 ERA while leading the Cardinals 11 strikeouts and 11 innings pitched over two starts. Senior left-hander Evan Webster has a 1.13 ERA and nine strikeouts in eight innings pitched over two starts.
- Louisville posted a 31-24 overall record with an 10-20 mark in ACC play in 2023. The Cardinals were picked fifth out of seven teams in the Atlantic Division in the 2024 ACC Baseball Coaches Preseason Poll.

- Louisville swept a three-game series at Jim Patterson Stadium on Feb. 23-25 during the 2018 season in the first-ever meetings between the programs. The Cardinals earn wins of 11-0, 8-1 and 12-2 in the first three meetings.

## RECAPPING LAST WEEK

### Game 1 at College of Charleston – Friday, Feb. 23 // L 1-2

- College of Charleston scored two runs in the bottom of the fifth to rally for a 2-1 victory over Youngstown State in the series opener on Friday at Patriots Point in Mt. Pleasant, S.C.
- The Penguins went ahead 1-0 on Teddy Ruffner's second home run of the season in the top of the second inning. The Cougars produced a pair of two-out runs in the bottom of the fifth inning and held on for the series-opening win.
- YSU starter Jacob Gehring suffered the loss after allowing two runs on four hits with three strikeouts and four walks over 4.2 innings in his second outing as a Penguin. The junior right-hander retired the side in the order in the first inning as he blanked the Cougars over the first four frames.
- Freshman left-hander Niall Todd allowed two hits while recording the final out of the fifth inning in his second career appearance. Nolan Kubilus pitched a scoreless sixth with a pair of punch outs, freshman right-hander Chris Domke worked a scoreless seventh and Casey Marshalwitz came on to toss a scoreless eighth.
- Freshman right fielder Alejandro Covas went 2-for-4 with a pair of singles and two stolen bases to lead YSU offensively.

### Game 2 at College of Charleston – Saturday, Feb. 24 // L 5-14

- College of Charleston used an 11-run sixth inning to break a 3-3 tie and pull away for a 14-5 victory over Youngstown State on Saturday afternoon at Patriots Point.
- The Cougars scored single runs in the second, fourth and fifth innings to build a 3-0 lead before the Penguins evened the score with three runs in the top of the sixth. College of Charleston responded by scoring 11 runs on five hits in the bottom of the sixth to pull away for the series victory. YSU added a pair of runs in the top of the seventh to produce the final margin.
- Trey Law matched his career high with four hits by going 4-for-5 with a pair of RBI singles and a stolen base. Derrick Tarpley Jr. went 2-for-5 with a double, an RBI and a stolen base while Alejandro Covas was 2-for-5 with a double and two runs scored. Matt Thompson also had a two-hit day as YSU outhit College of Charleston 13-8 while leaving a total of 13 runners on base. The Penguins posted season highs with five runs and 13 hits in Saturday's setback.
- YSU starter Sloan Ulrich surrendered three runs on three hits and four walks with two strikeouts over four innings in a no-decision. Aidan English took the loss after allowing two runs on a pair of walks in the decisive bottom of the sixth inning. English was one of four Penguin relievers to allow multiple runs in the sixth, and he was one of nine YSU pitchers to appear in the game.

### Game 3 at College of Charleston – Sunday, Feb. 25 // L 0-13

- College of Charleston struck for two big innings offensively and had two pitchers combine for a one-hit performance in a 13-0 victory over Youngstown State in the series finale on Sunday afternoon at Patriots Point.
- CofC starter Connor Campbell did allow a base runner until Matt Thompson sent a two-out single to right field in the top of the eighth inning. Campbell allowed one hit and struck out three batters over 7.2 scoreless innings to earn the win.
- YSU starter Braden Gebhardt suffered the loss after allowing five runs on five hits with three strikeouts and three walks over 2.1 innings in his first start of the season. Nick Perez was responsible for six runs on five hits and four walks in 1.2 innings before Casey Marshalwitz surrendered two runs on three hits in one inning. Lane Rhodes allowed one hit over two scoreless innings while Cam Marshalwitz tossed a scoreless eighth inning in his first appearance of the campaign.

Law Coming Off Breakout 2023 Campaign

- Redshirt senior shortstop Trey Law is coming off a breakout 2023 season. The Camp Hill, Pa., native was named to the All-Horizon League Second Team and the ABCA/Rawlings East All-Region Second Team last season after batting .362 and slugging .452 with 80 hits, 17 doubles, one home run and 29 RBIs. He also recorded 50 runs scored, 24 walks, 100 total bases, a .437 on-base percentage and 10 stolen bases while starting 52 games at shortstop.
- Law led the Horizon League in hits in 2023 while ranking second in batting average, fifth in doubles and on-base percentage and sixth in runs scored. Law’s 80 hits tied for the third most in a season in program history and were the most by a Penguin since 2010 while his 50 runs scored tied for the eighth most in a single season in school history. Law’s .362 batting average was the highest mark by a Penguin since 2015.
- Law hit safely in 43 of his final 49 games last season. He put together a season-best 15-game hitting streak from April 15 to May 18. Law led the team with 22 multi-hit games while batting .375 against left-handed pitching and .400 with runners in scoring position. He batted .350 and slugged .444 with eight doubles, one home run and 16 RBIs over 27 starts in Horizon League play. Law was named Horizon League Co-Batter of the Week on Feb. 28, 2023.
- Law had played in a total of 57 games and made 31 starts for the Penguins prior to the 2023 season.

Thompson Returns After Stellar Debut Season

- Sophomore infielder Matt Thompson became the first player in YSU history to be named Horizon League Freshman of the Year in 2023. Thompson, who was also selected to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team, batted .316 and slugged .439 with 54 hits, 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs and 28 RBIs. He played in 47 games and made 46 starts at second base during his debut collegiate campaign.
- Thompson ranked eighth in the Horizon League with a .316 batting average and a .421 on-base percentage last season. The Akron, Ohio, native became just the seventh YSU freshman to bat at least .300 since YSU joined the Horizon League in 2002. He was the first YSU freshman to bat at least .300 since Jason Shirley hit .303 in 2012. Thompson batted .324 and slugged .480 with five doubles, three home runs and 20 RBIs in Horizon League play.

## Freshmen Making Immediate Impact

- Youngstown State has seen a number of its talented freshmen make an immediate impact through the first six games of the 2024 season.
- Freshman outfielder Alejandro Covas leads the Penguins with a .353 batting average, a .389 on-base percentage and two stolen bases while ranking second on the squad with six hits and a .412 slugging percentage. Covas has played in five games while starting four games in right field. Freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. has recorded four hits including a double, two RBIs and a stolen base while starting all six games in center field.
- On the mound, freshmen Colin Casteel, Niall Todd, Chris Domke and Gavin Wilms have each made at least two appearances through the first six games of the season. Casteel tossed three straight scoreless frames during his 5.1 innings on the mound in his collegiate debut in the season opener at Texas State on Feb. 16.

## Penguin Power Surge Continues

- Youngstown State set a new single-season school record with 123 doubles as a team in 2023. The previous record of 115 was set in 2010. The Penguins ranked 49th nationally in total doubles while ranking 31st in the country with 2.24 doubles per game. YSU also set a new single-season school record with 190 extra-base hits in 2023, surpassing the previous mark of 183 that was also set in 2010.
- In addition, YSU's 54 home runs as a team in 2023 rank as the second most in a season in program history behind the school record of 60 that was set in 2010. The 2023 season marked just the fourth time in school history that the Penguins have hit at least 50 home runs – three of those occurrences have come during Dan Bertolini's tenure as head coach.
- Furthermore, four of the program's five-highest home run totals have come in Bertolini's first seven seasons at the helm. The 2023 season also marked the only campaign in YSU history that four different players hit at least eight homers.
- YSU tied the single-game school record with six home runs as a team in a 12-4 victory at Northern Kentucky on May 13, 2023. YSU hit six homers in a game for the third time in school history and for the first time since May 6, 2001, at Oakland.
- Former Penguin outfielder Andre Good tied the single-game school record with three home runs in a 17-13 victory at Northern Kentucky on May 14, 2023. Good hit three of YSU's five home runs in the game to become just the fourth player in school history to hit three homers in a game. He became the first Penguin to blast three dingers in a single contest since Lorenzo Arcuri at Morehead State on March 7, 2017.

## Pitching Staff Returns Key Pieces

- Youngstown State returns several key pieces from last year's pitching staff that was hit hard by injuries throughout the 2023 season. The Penguins bring back seven pitchers who logged at least 23 innings on the mound last season.
- Sophomore left-hander Braden Gebhardt headlines the group of returners after earning a spot on the Horizon League All-Freshman Team in 2023. The Howland, Ohio, native posted a 3-3 record, a 6.29 ERA, one save and 54 strikeouts in 63 innings pitched over 21 appearances and nine starts. Gebhardt's 54 strikeouts are the most by a YSU freshman since Collin Floyd had 58 in 2016. He became just the fourth YSU freshman to record at least 50 strikeouts since YSU joined the Horizon League in 2002.
- After making 29 relief appearances in 2022, senior right-hander Casey Marshalwitz made a career-high 30 appearances out of the bullpen in 2023. Marshalwitz's 30 appearances are tied for the second most in a season in program history. The Gibsonia, Pa., native made the most pitching appearances by a Penguin since Kevin McCulloh set the single-season school record with 32 appearances in 2012. Marshalwitz became just the third player in YSU history to make at least 30 appearances in a single season.
- Marshalwitz's six saves in 2023 are tied for the sixth most in a season in program history. The senior's six saves last season also ranked second in the Horizon League. He is expected

to anchor the back end of YSU's bullpen as a fifth-year senior in 2024. Marshalwitz enters the 2024 campaign ranking 20th in YSU history with 64 career appearances. He needs 10 appearances to move into the top 10 on the YSU career appearances list.

Impact Group of Transfers

- YSU brought in five talented transfers for the 2024 season who are expected to make a significant impact. The group of transfers includes junior right-hander and Ohio State transfer Jacob Gehring, who returns home to the Mahoning Valley after spending two seasons with the Buckeyes. The Canfield, Ohio, native and South Range High School graduate made 25 relief appearances and five starts for OSU over the past two seasons.
- Junior infielder Brett Stanley played in 100 games over the past two seasons at Kellogg Community College. He batted .319 and slugged .406 with 51 hits, five doubles, three home runs and 29 RBIs over 50 games played as a freshman in 2022. Stanley batted .369 and slugged .564 with 66 hits, 13 doubles, two triples, six home runs and 48 RBIs over 50 games as a sophomore in 2023.
- Sophomore left-hander Sloan Ulrich was named the 2023 Ohio Community College Athletic Conference (OCCAC) Pitcher of the Year last season at Cuyahoga Community College. He finished with a 3-1 record, a 3.88 ERA and 55 strikeouts in 48.2 innings pitched. Junior outfielder Teddy Ruffner played in nine games over two seasons at UNC Wilmington. Junior right-hander Nolan Kubilus made 17 appearances over two seasons at San Diego City College.

Youth Movement

- Youngstown State boasts a relatively young roster in 2024 with 15 freshmen and 11 sophomores. In addition, the Penguins have 10 juniors and only four players listed as seniors on this year's squad. The group of freshmen includes 12 true freshmen and three redshirt freshmen. The Guins also return nine players who saw the first action of their collegiate careers during the 2023 campaign.
- YSU's large group of incoming freshmen is highlighted by outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr., who was drafted by the Oakland Athletics with the 526th overall pick in the 18th round of the 2023 MLB Draft. The Brownsville, Pa., native played for Coach Scott Roebuck at Brownsville Area High School. He batted .651 and slugged 1.069 with 28 hits, two home runs, three doubles, five triples, 22 runs scored, 13 stolen bases and a .700 on-base percentage as a junior in 2022.

Success Against Power Five Opponents

- With two wins at Baylor in early March and a win at Pitt on April 10 in 2023, YSU now has five wins over Power Five opponents over the last two campaigns. YSU has collected nine Power Five victories during Dan Bertolini's tenure as head coach. YSU's 7-5 victory at Baylor on March 3, 2023, marked its first win over a Big 12 opponent since 2013.
- YSU earned two road wins over Power Five opponents in 2022. YSU defeated ACC member Pitt 5-2 on March 16 before beating Big Ten member Penn State 2-1 on March 22. The win against Penn State was YSU's first win over a Big Ten opponent since 1996.
- With a 9-4 victory at Pitt on April 10, 2023, the Penguins have now won three straight games over the Panthers in Pittsburgh. YSU also has five wins in the last eight meetings. The Penguins have a win over the Panthers in each of the last four seasons the programs have faced off. The Penguins also earned a 12-3 victory at Georgia Tech on Feb. 26, 2017, that was Bertolini's first win as YSU's head coach.

Replacing Key Pieces

- Several of YSU's younger players are getting the opportunity to step in and fill the void left from a number of key departures to graduation and the transfer portal. The Penguins lost five starting position players from last season as well as their top pitcher in terms of games started and innings pitched.

YSU BASEBALL ON YSN



The Youngstown State University Department of Intercollegiate Athletics has continued its partnership with Youngstown-area sports website Your Sports Network (YSNLive.com) to broadcast YSU baseball games for the 2024 season. YSN will stream all 20 of the Penguins’ home games at Eastwood Field and select road contests throughout the season. Each broadcast will feature streaming audio with Youngstown State sports broadcasting major Tim Corso handling the primary play-by-play duties. All live broadcasts will be free for fans with archived versions available for purchase.

- Youngstown State will look to replace five position players who each started at least 43 games in 2023. The Guins also lost Travis Perry to graduation, who led the team with 14 starts and 73.1 innings pitched last season.

Roster Composition

- There are 40 players on YSU’s roster in 2024, and 23 of them were with the program last year. The Penguins return 18 letterwinners from last year’s team and have 17 newcomers to the roster. The 2024 roster consists of four seniors, 10 juniors, 11 sophomores and 15 freshmen. The group of 17 newcomers includes 12 true freshmen and five transfers.
- Youngstown State’s 2024 roster includes 19 players from Ohio and 15 from Pennsylvania. The roster also features 12 players from the greater Mahoning Valley and 10 who hail from Western Pennsylvania.

Schedule Notes

- YSU opened the 2024 season on Friday, Feb. 16, at Texas State as part of a three-game series. The Penguins will proceed to play their first 16 games of the season on the road.
- The Penguins’ home and Horizon League opener at Eastwood Field is March 15 against Purdue Fort Wayne. YSU is scheduled for 20 home games and 30 Horizon League contests as part of its 55-game slate. The Guins will also play 10 games against four different opponents from Power Five conferences. Youngstown State is scheduled to play contests across nine different states in 2024.

Tarpley Jr. Named Preseason Horizon League Freshman of the Year

- Youngstown State freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was named the Preseason Horizon League Freshman of the Year by D1Baseball.com in the website’s 2024 conference preview.
- Tarpley Jr., a native of Brownsville, Pa., was drafted by the Oakland Athletics with the 526th overall pick in the 18th round of the 2023 Major League Baseball Draft this past summer. He played for Coach Scott Roebuck at Brownsville Area High School during his prep career.
- Tarpley Jr. batted .651 and slugged 1.069 with 28 hits, two home runs, three doubles, five triples, 22 runs scored, 13 stolen bases and a .700 on-base percentage as a junior in 2022. He posted 48 hits, 18 doubles, six triples, five home runs, 36 RBIs and 19 stolen bases over 32 games played during the summer of 2022. Tarpley Jr. was a three-time All-County selection and a three-time All-Section honoree during his high school baseball career.

Five Penguins Earn Preseason Recognition from D1Baseball.com

- In addition to Derrick Tarpley Jr. being named the Preseason Horizon League Freshman of the Year, three Penguins were listed among D1Baseball.com’s top MLB Draft prospects in the Horizon League in the website’s 2024 conference preview.
- Senior outfielder RJ Sherwood was ranked as the No. 7 prospect for the 2024 MLB Draft while junior right-hander Jacob Gehring was ranked No. 9. Sophomore infielder and reigning Horizon League Freshman of the Year Matt Thompson was ranked as the No. 2 prospect for the 2025 MLB Draft. In addition, freshman right-hander Gavin Wilms joined Tarpley Jr. on the website’s list of the top-10 Impact Freshmen in the conference.
- Sherwood played in 43 games and made 32 starts in right field during his debut season as a Penguin in 2023. He batted .226 and slugged .492 with nine doubles, eight home runs and 21 RBIs overall. The Canton, Mich., native increased his production in league action, batting .301 and slugging .658 with eight doubles, six home runs and 17 RBIs over 23 games played and 19 starts in Horizon League play last season.
- D1Baseball.com picked Youngstown State to finish fourth in the Horizon League standings in 2024. Wright State, the defending regular season and tournament champions, were picked as the favorite to win the league title. Northern Kentucky was selected to finish second behind the Raiders while Oakland was tabbed to finish third. Milwaukee and Purdue Fort Wayne were picked fifth and sixth, respectively, in the website’s preseason rankings.





**Bertolini's Bio**  
*Head Coach • Eighth Season*

Dan Bertolini, a Youngstown native with a proven record of winning and recruiting talented players from the region, is in his eighth season as head coach of the YSU baseball program. He is the ninth head coach in Penguins history.

Bertolini came to YSU after spending the previous eight seasons developing the program at Mercyhurst North East into a consistent winner at the national level. The Saints averaged more than 29 wins over his eight seasons and won at least 30 games in four of his last five years. He was the winningest coach in school history.

Most recently in 2023, the Penguins posted an overall record of 19-36 with a 13-16 mark in Horizon League play. Bertolini has now guided the program to double-digit Horizon League wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. With 10 road victories in 2023, Youngstown State has also recorded double-digit road wins in three straight seasons for the first time since 2005-07.

The 2023 campaign was highlighted by the program's longest winning streak in 18 years. YSU won eight straight games from April 25 to May 9 to put together its longest winning streak since the 2005 season. The Penguins won 12 of their final 16 games while earning four consecutive Horizon League series victories to close out the regular season.

## Penguins Picked Fifth in Horizon League Preseason Poll

- The Youngstown State baseball team was predicted to finish fifth in the Horizon League in 2024 after a vote of the league's head coaches.
- Wright State, the defending regular season and tournament champion, was picked to win the 2024 championship. The Raiders received 34 points and four of six first-place votes. Northern Kentucky was selected second with 28 points and one first-place vote while Oakland earned 22 points and one first-place vote to be placed third in the poll. Milwaukee was slotted fourth with 16 points while Youngstown State was tabbed fifth with 15 points. Purdue Fort Wayne checked in at sixth in the poll with 11 points.
- The 2024 Horizon League Baseball Championship will take place on May 22-25 at the home site of the highest seed.

## Six Penguins Earn Preseason Recognition from Perfect Game

- Redshirt senior shortstop Trey Law and sophomore infielder Matt Thompson were each named to Perfect Game's Horizon League Preseason All-Conference Team in the website's 2024 conference preview.
- In addition, six different Penguins were listed among Perfect Game's Top MLB Draft Prospects in the Horizon League. Junior right-hander Jacob Gehring was ranked the league's No. 9 prospect for the 2024 MLB Draft. He was joined on the website's top-25 prospects for 2024 by Law (No. 21), senior outfielder RJ Sherwood (No. 23) and junior catcher Ian Francis (No. 25). Thompson was listed as Perfect Game's top 2025 MLB Draft prospect while freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was ranked as the league's No. 2 Top MLB Draft prospect for 2026.
- Francis returns after a successful sophomore season that saw him play in 43 games and make 39 starts behind the plate while earning a spot on the 2023 Horizon League All-Academic Team. The Youngstown, Ohio, native batted .287 and slugged .475 with 35 hits, eight doubles, five home runs and 25 RBIs last season. He batted .315 and slugged .521 with six doubles, three home runs and 14 RBIs over 23 games played and 21 starts in Horizon League play.

## Preseason Poll Results

- D1Baseball.com picked YSU to finish fourth in the Horizon League in its projected conference standings. Wright State, the 2023 regular season and tournament champion, was tabbed as the preseason favorite while Northern Kentucky was selected second and Oakland was picked third. Milwaukee was slotted fifth while Purdue Fort Wayne was picked sixth.
- The Penguins were picked fifth in the 2024 Horizon League Baseball Preseason Poll. Wright State edged out Northern Kentucky as the preseason favorite in a vote of the league’s head coaches. The Raiders received four of six first-place votes.
- In the league’s poll, Oakland was picked third while Milwaukee checked in one spot ahead of the Penguins in fourth. Purdue Fort Wayne was slotted sixth.

## Law, Thompson Named to Perfect Game’s Horizon League Preseason All-Conference Team

- Redshirt senior shortstop Trey Law and sophomore infielder Matt Thompson were each named to Perfect Game’s Horizon League Preseason All-Conference Team in the website’s 2024 conference preview.
- Law was named to the All-Horizon League Second Team and the ABCA/Rawlings East All-Region Second Team last season after batting .362 and slugging .452 with 80 hits, 17 doubles, one home run and 29 RBIs. He also recorded 50 runs scored, 24 walks, 100 total bases, a .437 on-base percentage and 10 stolen bases while starting 52 games at shortstop.
- Thompson, who was named the 2023 Horizon League Freshman of the Year, batted .316 and slugged .439 with 54 hits, 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs and 28 RBIs while playing in 47 games and making 46 starts at second base during his debut collegiate campaign.

## Five Penguins Earn Recognition from D1Baseball.com

- Freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was named the Preseason Horizon League Freshman of the Year by D1Baseball.com in the website’s 2024 conference preview. Tarpley was drafted by the Oakland Athletics with the 526th overall pick in the 18th round of the 2023 Major League Baseball Draft.
- Senior outfielder RJ Sherwood was ranked as the No. 7 prospect for the 2024 MLB Draft while junior right-hander and Ohio State transfer Jacob Gehring was ranked No. 9. Sophomore infielder and reigning Horizon League Freshman of the Year Matt Thompson was ranked as the No. 2 prospect for the 2025 MLB Draft. In addition, freshman right-hander Gavin Wilms joined Tarpley Jr. on the website’s list of the top-10 Impact Freshmen in the conference.

## Six Penguins Earn Recognition from Perfect Game

- Six different Penguins were listed among Perfect Game’s Top MLB Draft Prospects in the Horizon League when the website released its 2024 conference preview. Junior right-hander and Ohio State transfer Jacob Gehring was ranked the league’s No. 9 prospect for the 2024 MLB Draft. He was joined on the website’s top-25 prospects for 2024 by Law (No. 21), senior outfielder RJ Sherwood (No. 23) and junior catcher Ian Francis (No. 25).
- Thompson was listed as Perfect Game’s top 2025 MLB Draft prospect while freshman outfielder Derrick Tarpley Jr. was ranked as the league’s No. 2 Top MLB Draft prospect for 2026.

## 2023 IN REVIEW

- The Penguins posted an overall record of 19-36 with a 13-16 mark in Horizon League play in 2023. Dan Bertolini has now guided the program to double-digit Horizon League wins in three straight seasons for the first time in program history. With 10 road victories in 2023, Youngstown State has also recorded double-digit road wins in three straight seasons for the first time since 2005-07.
- The 2023 campaign was highlighted by YSU’s longest winning streak in 18 years. YSU won eight straight games from April 25 to May 9 to put together its longest winning streak since 2005. The Penguins won 12 of their final 16 games while earning four consecutive Horizon League series victories to close out the regular season.
- Youngstown State set a new single-season school record with 123 doubles as a team in 2023. The previous record of 115 was set in 2010. The Penguins ranked 49th nationally in total doubles while ranking 31st in the country with 2.24 doubles per game. YSU also set a new single-season school record with 190 extra-base hits in 2023, surpassing the previous mark of 183 that was also set in 2010.
- YSU’s 54 home runs as a team in 2023 rank as the second most in a season in program history behind the school record of 60 that was set in 2010. The 2023 season marks just the fourth time in school history that the Penguins have hit at least 50 home runs – three of those occurrences have come during Dan Bertolini’s tenure as head coach. The 2023 season also marks the only campaign in YSU history that four different players hit at least eight homers.
- With two wins at Baylor in early March and a victory at Pitt on April 10 last season, YSU has now earned five victories against Power Five opponents over the past two campaigns. Youngstown State has collected nine Power Five victories over Dan Bertolini’s first seven seasons as head coach. YSU’s 7-5 victory at Baylor on March 3, 2023, marked the program’s first win over a Big 12 opponent since 2013.
