TASKS OF CATECHESIS

Catechesis pursues several interconnected tasks that are inspired by the way in which Jesus formed his disciples:

- he got them to **know** the mysteries of the Kingdom,
- taught them to **pray**,
- proposed to them gospel values,
- initiated them into the life of communion with him and among themselves,
- and into mission.


The Catechumenal Process, Parish Life, and Adaptability






