Login

When the user first opens the Thrive Replenish site the user will enter their user name and password. The Sign In action button will be active when the daily job has completed. If there is an issue with the daily jobs the Sign In button will be greyed out and the message “Nightly Jobs are Still Running” will be displayed above the Sign In button.

Thrive Message Center

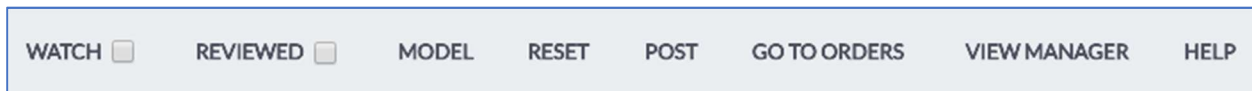
The Thrive Message Center is used to provide daily communications to the users as to the status of the daily jobs, additional information concerning future upgrades, current upgrades, and any additional information pertaining the client’s needs.

Standard Web Navigation



The application leverages web functionality to provide intuitive navigation:

- ◆ Words, phrases or numbers that are underlined and display the pointer hand when passed over with the mouse **VIEW MANAGER** are commonly called “links” and can be clicked to initiate a move to another screen or to view a new window.
- ◆ The gray box with an arrow represents a drop down menu. The arrow can be clicked to display a list from which users may select.
- ◆ Single and double blue arrowheads to the left and right of a word **Location** enable scrolling through a list by clicking on the arrowheads.
- ◆ Action buttons appear below the main ribbon in the upper right hand corner of the screen,



All functionality is organized into workboxes to enable the user to focus on primary job functions, but with one-click access to other functions. Each workbox has a header name and, an **EXPAND** button to expand and contract respective workboxes. To close the workbox, the **HIDE** button is clicked once.

Application Organization

The application is organized into five main menus, as illustrated here:

- ◆ Buying
- ◆ Performance
- ◆ SKU Detail
- ◆ Special Tasks
- ◆ Admin



The five areas of the application and their functions are persistent on the left side of the screen in the navigation bar. This area of the screen allows the user to navigate from one functional area of the application to another from any point in the application. The main window of the screen is the user workspace and will change as the user navigates from one area to the next or opens or closes various workboxes within the workspace.

Thrive Replenish organizes each screen into functional workboxes. The workboxes always open on a screen contain the data and functions that are used most often. Many of the workboxes are closed, showing the workbox header and the button that opens and closes it.

Go To SKU

The *GoTo SKU* function provides a method to navigate directly to the detail forecast or replenishment data of an SKU by entering the item number and location if the item and location is known. In the event that you do not know the item number you can utilize the *Search by Description* function to locate the item number that you are in search of. The *Go to SKU* is similar to the *Watch List* as it remains open until the user closes the box.
