# ADDRESSING THE ISSUES "The Main Issue—Resurrection" 1 Corinthians 15:1-58

The Corinthians were skeptical about the resurrection of the dead. But Paul insisted Christianity hinges on the Resurrection of Christ. It's the main issue!
