- 7. What power dynamics are at play between the activists, the police, the victims and the broader community that brothels exist in?
- 8. What social conditions exist to make the enforcement of anti-trafficking laws difficult?
- 9. Are activists responsible for ensuring the enforcement of anti-trafficking laws? Why or why not?
- 10. The activists rely heavily on the police to rescue victims of sex trafficking. Can you think of any alternatives to relying solely on government law enforcement?
