1. Who are the stakeholders in this story?
2. What solutions were presented, if any?
3. What challenges remain?
4. What are some of the root causes of the problem being addressed?
5. Are there similar problems in your community?
6. Could similar solutions be applied?
7. What power dynamics are at play between the activists, the police, the victims and the broader community that brothels exist in?
8. What social conditions exist to make the enforcement of anti-trafficking laws difficult?
9. Are activists responsible for ensuring the enforcement of anti-trafficking laws? Why or why not?
10. The activists rely heavily on the police to rescue victims of sex trafficking. Can you think of any alternatives to relying solely on government law enforcement?
