Further exploration

- 1. Kashmir is one of the most militarized regions in the world, and also the source of rivers that irrigate the breadbaskets of both India and Pakistan. How does control of the Kashmir region shift the power dynamics between India and Pakistan? What developments since the broadcast of this story might affect the future of this region and relations between India and Pakistan?
- 2. Is the conflict in Kashmir primarily because of religious divides between Hindus and Muslims or the geopolitical importance of the region?
- 3. Conflict over Kashmir dates back to 1947 when Britain partitioned land between India and Pakistan. Should Britain bear any responsibility for the current conflict?
