Further exploration

- 1. It took years and a bit more than half a million dollars, mostly from European churches and individual donors, to restore almost 1,000-year-old images in the monastery. Why is it important to restore these cultural and religious symbols?
- 2. How can restoration of historical religious centers encourage interfaith dialogue?
- 3. Since this story aired, years of civil war have devastated Syria. How does war threaten cultural preservation?
- 4. In 2012, Father Paolo Dall'Oglio's disappeared, presumably abducted by the Islamic State, and he hasn't been seen since. Do you think his interfaith advocacy might have been seen as a threat?
