Civil War History

Carnton

Home of the New York Times bestseller The Widow of the South, this elegant house was used as a field hospital after the Battle of Franklin. Tours of the house, McGavock Cemetery, and seasonal garden are available.

Carter House

The Carter House, built in 1830, was caught in the center of the Civil War's Battle of Franklin. Daily tours include a video presentation, museum, and guided tour of the farmhouse and grounds.

Lotz House

LOTZHOUSE.COM

The Lotz House is located in downtown Franklin at the epicenter of the 1864 Battle of Franklin. This house features fine furnishing and antiques, including the Thompson collection that boasts an original painting by Matilda Lotz. Guided tours available.

McLemore House

MCLEMOREHOUSE.COM

Built by a former slave, this museum home chronicles the struggles, triumphs, and significant contributions of African Americans in Williamson County. Custom tours and additional tour times are available by reservation.

Historic Franklin and the unique communities of Williamson County are located just south of Nashville, Tennessee, easily accessible off Interstate 65 & State Route 840. Nashville International Airport offers over 350 flights daily from 10 airlines.
