The Visitor Center is located in the heart of downtown Franklin and offers information ranging from dining options to the history of Franklin.

## Civil War History

---

### Carnton

**BOFT.ORG**

Home of the New York Times bestseller *The Widow of the South*, this elegant house was used as a field hospital after the Battle of Franklin. Tours of the house, McGavock Cemetery, and seasonal garden are available.

### Carter House

**BOFT.ORG**

The Carter House, built in 1830, was caught in the center of the Civil War's Battle of Franklin. Daily tours include a video presentation, museum, and guided tour of the farmhouse and grounds.

### Lotz House

**LOTZHOUSE.COM**

The Lotz House is located in downtown Franklin at the epicenter of the 1864 Battle of Franklin. This house features fine furnishing and antiques, including the Thompson collection that boasts an original painting by Matilda Lotz. Guided tours available.

### McLemore House

**MCLEMOREHOUSE.COM**

Built by a former slave, this museum home chronicles the struggles, triumphs, and significant contributions of African Americans in Williamson County. Custom tours and additional tour times are available by reservation.

Built circa 1929, the historic Factory is a complex of 11 Depression-era factory buildings which have been renovated into one of Tennessee's most unique shopping, dining, and entertainment venues. Over 70 different shops, restaurants, artisans, and cafés are located inside the Factory, which is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places. Bus parking available.

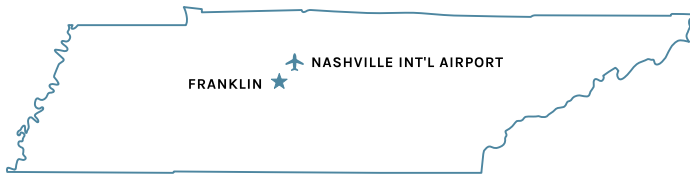




## 17 Miles South of Nashville
