13:1, 18:1-4-9

The conquest is complete but Joshua ^{c. 90} dies; people needed to settle
Reuben, Gad, $\frac{1}{2}$ Manasse on east side / Joshua
Levites, no inheritance. The other tribes = tribes and offspring
Judah, Ephraim, settled.
But seven tribes remaining. And the conquest not complete.

Twenty-one commissioners, surveyors, appointed to pass through
the land, examine it report back to Shiloh - Ithamar, Phineas,
Eleazar of Joshua 1:4 the measure of the land; of Solomon
for a long time approximated it. The ruler holds property of
hereditary, we do not possess what is ours. How much in

remained there for over 300 years.

Located in the very heart and center of Canaan. No striking
landmark distinguished the sight. A somewhat wide plain,
surrounded by low hills, north & south, on the east side of the
highway that runs from Jericho to Hebron.

In the wilderness north of the tabernacle in the center, 3
trees on each side. So the location, Shiloh.

The sacred name Shiloh = "peace" + "rest" = given by the
angel Gabriel to the Messiah. (Isa. 49:10).
Jesus is the center of his people - their love, affection, unity, peace
in heaven - this song of praise, worship

20:1-9 the cities of refuge

3 on each side of Jordan. Roads in repair, dustless clean routes.
