I. Proclaiming the Gospel

(1) what is "the gospel"?

I Cor. 15:1-4

Baptism demonstrates it Rom. 6:3-5
Col. 2:12

1. His death
not by his life, but by his death we are saved
1. q. the gospels. mostly, the last 3 years
2. q. Apostles Creed. Back to the apostles.
scape from world to the cross
death, supreme importance
Lamb meant to nourish, not to be used, but
not by his holy life, but of his stripes we are healed
3. q. great leader, known by words, teaching, - given by death
your Teacher, preacher, Reframer, Example. Paul Senior.
4. q. Apocalypse 5:6 "a Lamb slain"

2. His Resurrection

Acts. 5:10

8:25

The 4th experience in all 4 forms implies the resurrection

1. Xp began in a resurrection experience
2. The day (Sunday) the next
3. The burial, then dead (with a tomb, at least)
4. Other religious immortality; Xp resurrected
5. The sanctity of the body: 1st (the 1st)
