 Apostle: " 18:28 "publicly shown by the Scriptures that Jesus was"  
 Paul: I Cor: 15 "according to the Scriptures"

of Nahum. Many of the predictions uttered by the prophets concern, not only a coming Chait, but concern great contemporary nations. Assyria, capital Niniveh on banks of the Tigris. No nation on horizon of world able to challenge her, Whipped ~~her~~ of Assyria swept off the world. Destroyed 10 times of Nineveh, Samaria. Yet Nahum predicts siege of Niniveh - Chait's march is his highway, scarlet uniforms in streets, copper spears, burnished, dismal king, the slain, spiriting, tangles, gables, years later, confederacy of Medes, Persians, Chaldees led by Nabopolassar (father of Nebuchadnezzar) destroyed entire city, but for two years failed to dent the city. Then a sudden rise in the Tigris swept away part of the wall. When flood subsided, ground through the breach. Nahum 2:6 "the gate, the river shall be opened, the palace shall be destroyed."

As Nahum says. Niniveh so completely destroyed, as neither sand beneath had gone, criticizing that even is classical times it became a myth. In his Anabasis, Xenophon tells how the 10,000 Greek Caragers were saved with difficulty, which they supposed to be Niniveh. All early records visit the site, which they supposed to be Niniveh. of Jesus' Ministry; "To declare a thing shall come to pass long before it is being, and then to bring it to pass, that a nothing, is the word of God."

This great evidence is peculiar to X. No other religious legends or appeal to the fulfillment of prophecy. X accepts the greatest of tests, of our man, certain type, a prediction of the coming of our Lord Jesus, that substitution fulfillment, that is, surely would be of infinite importance. But instead of our man at our time in history... many different predictions, uttered by many different men through many hundreds of years, all at last converging to Jesus X. Many of those predictions apparently contradictory - congruous yet long, despised, cast out.

of the firm mind of Pascal saw in the fulfillment of the prophecies the strongest of all evidence for X. He said: "The greatest of the proofs of Jesus Christ are the prophecies. They are also what have been most provided for, for the event which has fulfilled them is a miracle which has subsisted from the birth of Christ even to the end."
