Salamis. Synagogues pl. The Jews numerous. In (now) Tragia (116) the  
Jews in Cyprus so powerful they rose and massacred 240,000 of the  
Greeks in Salamis. In revenge for this slaughter, Hadrian, who's father became  
emperor, landed on the island, with just to death or exile the entire  
Jewish population.

Paphos. At the other end of the island. Distance c. 100 miles. Capital of  
the island. [Now <sup>the capital is in</sup> Nicosia. British plan, naval base - Cyprus. Because the

Greek adjective ΚΟΥΡΕΤΟΣ "intelligent," "having understanding," "wise," "learned."  
They were able to captivate, mislead, the governor Paulus as described?  
A true picture of the times. Impostors from the East pretending to great  
magical powers had great influence over the Roman mind. The East,  
just recently thrown open, were the land of mystery to the Western world.  
Reports of the strange arts practiced, wonderful works of which it the  
news, & later almost fantastically the magical arts of the populace  
at the citadels of Rome. Marcellus relied on "Jewish prophets"  
for regulating his campaigns. Pompey, Crassus, Caesar, sought  
information from Oriental astrology. Juvenal paints to us the  
Emperor Tiberius "sitting on the rock of Capri with his flock of  
Chaldeans round him." Tacitus says the astrologers, Graeci, <sup>were</sup> sorcerers.

Procurred, ad uitatos. On the establishment of the Empire, Caesar  
Augustus divided the provinces into two classes. Those which required  
a military force to be retained for security; the others he committed to  
the care of the Roman Senate. The government <sup>of the</sup> provinces  
was called [procurator] procurator, legatus; those sent into the Senate  
provinces were called proconsuls.

In years ago, critics said Luke made a mistake here.  
assigned to Paulus a false title, for the historian Strabo says that  
Augustus reserved Cyprus to himself, committed its administration to  
procurator, shows the matter true.

In recent years, a passage  
discovered in Dio Cassius (53.12) which states that four years later  
Augustus relinquished Cyprus to the Senate in exchange for another province  
on the frontier (54.4) it was governed by procurator. Paul & Barnabas  
were there during the reign of Claudius Caesar; coins have been found  
struck in the reign of Claudius, which confirm Luke's account. Two  
inscriptions have been found, with the names of the procurators of Cyprus,  
one of which names the very man Paulus as Procuror.

Saint, Paul. Paul a Roman citizen doubtless has three names from beginning, as John Mark, Simeon wife, Barnabas father. Jerome tells that Paul took the name from the conversion of the procurer. No. Luke uses Saint fully the Jewish saint / the story; now to the Britiles, "Paul," once on reference 22:7. 26:14, & his old life.
