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## THE COMING KING

The covenant - keeping God, So to Abraham.

Three different kinds of "seed" of Abraham

1. The literal posterity of Israel the natural descendants of Abraham. Gen. 22:17 [Gen. 1:1; Gen. 7 the 12 tribes + others after] Signature agrees with "to lot the land"

2. The spiritual seed of Abraham, the saved. Gal. 3:26-29

3. The seed, as we are, of promises. Gen. 12:3; 22:18  
Gal. 3:16

Last Sunday, the literal posterity

## The Davidic Covenant: a King and a Kingdom

II Sam? 12, 13, 16

Ps. 89: 3, 4, 20, 34, 29, 34-36

93-95 The King is the Shepherd - his Kingdom is the Sheep.

The Kingdom is the People.  
Usually asserted, of the day & kingdom as a kingdom, but in NT  
contradict all this. Specifically, a spiritual, invisible kingdom is the  
kingdom of heaven. Israel, the physical kingdom,  
earthly men, a church in heaven. Israel, the physical kingdom,  
forgotten, forsaken.

Mt 1: 32, 33; 2: 34 - briefly refer to OT predictions  
still referring to kingdom as

Matt. 20: 20-23 This with [Salome, sister, may, in behalf of

kingdom, this an opportunity time to explain it away. Spiritually the  
kingdom, that an opportunity to inj. plan, long prepared, to be harvested.

## The Kingdom in the Acts

Acts 1:6  
after eating up, Christ resurrected, thirty & the 40 days, at Jerusalem.  
still the leaders. It was very. Not in X to understand it.  
The question not about the leaders being restored, but when he  
would restore it to Israel (all in OT promises fulfilled).  
If we may say, again an opportunity here for Christ to say,  
"The leader promised you all at the fulfillment; I am a sufficient  
prophet to offer; I have taught all that." But did not say  
that. He does forget that the leader was lost.  
His answer is to this question: "we will know the kingdom, because  
you others should be now by the great church  
restored. Indeed, he divided his answer & does  
not tell us the kingdom. not to say to the leaders - but  
assigned tasks - witnesses. not to say to the leaders -  
do this with an mighty power. by an everyday righteousness.
