2. Shall we then say, there are absolutely no conditions?

two garage, servants quarters, fifty more fields - just ask.

- (1) — If this is mine and good, Yes.  
(2) — If this, mine & here you will never believe.  
(3) — a great desire, looking back upon his life, the granting of some of the  
short misgivings and longer forgotten would have been the sweetest  
thing that could have done. It need a father's refusal as well as a  
father's gift.

(4) — Oh Eldest, sayest. "Take away my life."  
*if necessary. Eldest

(5) Christ is all-sufficient.

3. *Earthly*  
3. The Father says, "I cannot give both now." Entrusted, at time of creation.  
*no man living who is innocent enough to be given both.* Both Eldest, more desired.

#### 2. The purpose of prayer.

- (1) To know, understand, do, the will of God.  
To rejoice in it, yield gladly to it, faithful in his works,  
in the gladness, in reality to the natural desires  
as well as the necessary serve to the faithful service.
