## REPENTANCE

Job 42:6 "Therefore I abhor myself, and repent in dust & ashes  
a. Strong words and odd, are they not for a man like us to be saying?  
I Peter 4: 17-18 ~ "In the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God; and if it first begin at us what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And of the rest why necessarily be saved, where shall be ungodly and the wicked appear?  
a. Enough said here to drive naked sinners into need salvation.

## I. GOD CALLS UPON SINNERS TO REPENT.

- 1) Eph. 3:11 ~ "As I live, saith the Lord, I have no pleasure in the sins of men: I have come to call sinners to repentance"
- 2) Acts 17:30 "God commands all men everywhere to repent"

- A. God calls upon proud, self-admitted sinners to repent  
1. Sprayed dolefully he looked to preach to this kind
- B. God calls upon those with wicked self-righteousness to repent  
1. I used to preach to this kind  
2. They say: "I don't need to repent. I'm as good as you have made me."  
a. John to them: "O ye generation of vipers. How full pride.  
2. Parable of the fig tree, damaged. TIME

## II. GOD IS QUICK TO FORGIVE.

1. Not what a man does - but his attitude towards his actions
1. David - sins - repentance (4:8 had sinned unto me the Lord has seen...)
2. Nineveh - mighty empire, long Sabbath - quick heart, repentance
3. Peter - carrying - running quickly  
God sees it not against David "he hath put away thy sins"  
Nineveh, Peter - it will be forgiven

- But is that wise, and does not repent
1. Prodigal son back home: like David, but "they spied him not along"
  2. Jesus says we shouldn't be surprised (Matt. 11:22) like Nineveh but  
Caymanian jester
  3. No repentance in Cain; Lamech; Judas; Unlike Peter

## III. THE WAY TO GOD - THE PATH OF REPENTANCE

Peter 4:18 for the love of money that judgment must begin at the house  
of God; and if I find anyone of us that shall be evil of them that obey

### I. GOD CALLS UPON SINNERS TO REPENT

- 1) Exod. 33:11 "As I live, saith the Lord I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked."  
2) Jesus "I have come to call sinners to repentance"  
A God calls upon hard self-entitled sinners to repent.  
Spurgeon declaring he lived to preach to real hard down-right sinners.  
He never intended to preach for a company, only a field.  
B. God calls impious self-entitled self-referring sinners to repent.  
I have to preach to this kind.  
How may they? I don't need to repent. I am as good as any of you chisel.  
John - "O of generation of vipers, how full your <sup>hearts</sup> of malice & corruption;  
and how art within <sup>your</sup> generation. I do this, I am bad."  
Jesus "Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish."

### II. God Is Quick To Forgive.

Yet what a man does - his attitude toward his acts

1. David - repentance O Lord restore unto me the joyous O Absalom my son, my son etc.
2. Noah - swift, others not lifted - God, repentance
3. Peter - Christ in curving - repented weeping bitterly  
God hate it not against David "to lift up away thy sin  
Brother - it shall be forgiven."  
Peter - "it shall be forgiven."

But is that possible, one does not repent.

Noah-1. People in Noah's day - My spirit will not always strive  
Noah-2. Jesus cry over <sup>Capernaum</sup> ~~Jerusalem~~ Matt. 11:22-24

1st 3. No repentance on Cain, Lamech, Judas  
this the way of death

### III. The Way To God The Way of Repentance

- 1) He sits in the high noon - through him I repent

I. The Children are Getting More to See.  
Being a member of a family do not beg or pray temptation,

B. No man is above this temptation - all subject to so erring

1. the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak
2. "He smote me twice, he remonstrated but we are not
3. Paul - "So great with me but had to perform  
that which is bad I find not. What I would not do if I  
watched never did I do."

C. This is the reason we are not to condemn, to judge

1. the sinner is his own master is our rule
2. let him that thinks he stands, take heed lest he fall.
3. knowing my own weak mortal nature, in loving properly  
I can be holy, not indomitable.

II. It is not the Erring that is no Iniquition, but the  
Continuing to Err, the Further to Repeat.

A. Not that a man has fallen but that he fails to rise.  
Not that he is got to catch with the hand, but that he stays at it.  
It is the hardening of the heart, the stiffening of the will.

B. The difference between Saul and David  
The difference between Judas and Peter  
A broken and a contrite heart, O Lord, thou wilt not despise.  
"Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man be high."

III. So Erring, then Repenting, What will keep us from  
falling again?

1. The admiring of you - "Watch and pray."
2. The moment Peter took his eyes off the Master of the sea
