THE COVENANTS

'Covenant': The dictionary, 'the promise', but as revealed in the Scriptures. An agreement, a contract. Sometimes accompanied by a "sign".

I. Edenic. conditions to life & man in innocence
Gen. 1: 26-30, 2: 15-17
of 1: 29, 30 man, animals & vegetable diet
Gen. 11: 6, 7: sabbath, millennium, 64 years.

II. Adamic. conditions to life, man fallen, gives promise of Redeemer
Gen. 3: 14-19

1. The curses

(1) The serpent: from a beautiful to a loathsome creature (some say beauty remains)
(3: 14)

(2) The woman: pain in childbirth
(3: 16)
: husband rule over her.

(3) The man: the ground cursed for his sake
(3: 17-19)

2. The promise.

3: 15 the seed, the woman.
note the singular, as you - it 'thy' 'thou' 'his'
of Gal. 3: 15-18

The Seven Covenants

"Covenant" = an agreement, a compact
= often attached by a sign

II. NOACHIC

Gen. 8: 21 - 9: 17

8: 22 the seasons established (the canopy house)
9: 3 no longer restricted to vegetation
9: 6 capital punishment established
9: 11 never a world-flood again

the sign: rainbow 9: 12-17

I. ADAMIC (EDENIC)

Gen. 3: 14-19

3: 14 curse of the serpent

3: 16 . . . woman

3: 17-19 . . . man

the promise 3: 15

III Noahian, Noachic established human gov.

Gen. 8:20-9:17

- (1) 8:22 the seasons
- (2) 9:3 no longer restricted to vegetation
- (3) 9:6 law of capital punishment established
- (4) 9:11 man's flood again to destroy the world

The signs: a rainbow 9:13-17

IV Abrahamic founds the nation / Israel

The new idolatrous: God called out me from a separate people. Covenant implies me to Isaac 26:1-5
Jacob 28:10-15

The signs: Circumcision 17:8-14

III. ABRAHAMIC

Gen. 12:1-3

confirmed to Isaac Gen. 26:1-5

" - Jacob - 28:10-15

the sign: circumcision - 17:9-14

IV MOSAIC

Ex. 20:1-26 the moral law

21:1-24:18 - civil law

25:1-40:38 - ceremonial law

the sign: the Sabbath Ex. 31:12-18

V Mosaic, includes all law
