I. The Destruction of Our Faculties, Senses, through Lack of Use.

What need to do, to blind my eyes?
Violent things - Act of violence, disease, torn out.
also, cover it over. Do not use.

What need to do, to deafen my ears?
Violent things - burnt ear drums...
also, stop my ears. Do not use.

What need to do, to paralyze my arms?
Violent things - torn... muscles, bones, nerves...
also, do not use. Bind for awhile.
