II The universal drug traffic

In many parts, the U.S. and other western nations have the highest rate of drug-alcohol abuse.

Now, affects the whole earth.

The social problems related to the use
of drugs are multitudinous.

25 years ago, 2% of U.S. high school
students had experimented with illicit
drugs. Now, more than 70%

10,000 young people die each year in
auto accidents, drug-related related.

a cause for youth suicides

crime - cities like N.Y., San Francisco;
7 out of 10 crimes drug-related related

Here in U.S., the illicit drug
traffic amounts to more than a
hundred million dollars a year -
money taken from family needs.

Our ^{PRISONS} are jammed for drug ^{ARRESTS} counts
Our ^{PRISONS} courts docket are jammed.

For the past decade, according to Gary Bauer, U.S. Under Secretary of Education, "It has become the conventional wisdom within the academic establishment that moral education is illegitimate because it constitutes 'indoctrination.'"

"Teachers are given the impression that moral education is unscientific, unprofessional and oppressive. They are constantly reminded that if they teach values, they are entering into the unconstitutional domain of religion.

"Our public school teachers are no longer sure of what values to teach and how to go about teaching them," Mr. Bauer wrote in last year's fall edition of *Policy Review*, the quarterly journal of the Heritage Foundation.

~~Some educators feel that religion can be taught "about" in public schools without promoting sectarian views. But others feel any talk of religion should be absolutely avoided, that instruction in values should be based on maintaining a strong secular democratic society.~~
