Heb. 2:4 ΣΗΜΕΙΩΝ - a miracle or  
a sign authenticating the divine mission, the done  
act 2:22 ΤΕΡΑΣ - a miracle as a wonderful thing, names from effort of  
ΔΥΝΑΜΙΣ - an exhibition of divine power.

Definition of a miracle: an <sup>temporary suspension</sup> interruption, intercession, in the system of  
nature as we ordinarily know it. "Supernatural" above the natural.  
of its origin but. No other explanation but the sovereignty of God.  
a sovereign work, God, a manifestation, divine power, given to substantiate a message  
Sometimes we see the word in a figurative sense:  
"a sunset is a miracle" (beauty, beauty)  
"a year" (patience, self-sacrifice?)  
"a note" (...)

But this not the sense of  
turning compass dead into rivers (cross)  
dividing a stream by the magic of a mantle (Elijah) (Elisha)  
feeding 5,000 with 5 loaves & fish.  
to turn water into wine through process, nature and that  
by faith, sovereign act - proof for nature  
that is a miracle.

The gift of miracles  
 (The gift of healing, <sup>miracles put in I Cor 12:9</sup> a specific category within the larger gift of miracles.  
 miracles not truly healing; Jesus <sup>showed power for himself</sup> ~~showed power for himself~~ <sup>healed 8,000, mostly on Mt</sup>  
 Peter, raising ~~deaf~~ <sup>blind</sup> man <sup>Acts 9:36-43</sup>  
 Paul calling blind men down eyes <sup>Chrysostr. Acts 13:8-11</sup>  
 Paul raising <sup>dead</sup> ~~dead~~ <sup>Acts 20:9-12</sup>

1. Jesus  
 Intro book: on, authentication, confirmation, substantiation  
 Focus great ex of miracles, each intruding a new age, i.e. Born a special testimony at the beginning and new age.

 5. The incarnation of the Logos, Incarnation

 Never performed to to sports unless; never? attract people to the miracle worker  
 of Jesus and 2 <sup>as</sup> temptations Matt. 4:5-7  
 of Jesus and Herod Antipas Jh. 23:5-11  
 of Jesus and the Jews regarding signs Matt. 12:38-40  
 For the most part, miracle of Jesus and of the apostles workers of compassion, love, mercy.

3. Converts not made by them  
 of Jesus: the Cyprianism a fantasy <sup>John 6</sup> looking for the leaders and the flock.  
 : rulers, the nation rejects. attributed to Satan  
 : Over tagarun, cause to be destroyed  
 : teaching about Jesus Jh. 16:22-31

of Paul: Acts 16:16-24 trouble raised, because someone had heard  
 Acts 14:8-19 a god. Then returned. no faith awakened in hearts  
 The apostles never sought to evangelize through miracles. They relied  
 entirely upon the convincing and repenting words of the Logos.  
 No miracle recorded in Colossae, Antioch, Iconia, Tarsus, Berea, Athens, Corinth, Crete.

Apostles: miracle like the Lord: miracle / companion, many, how

4. The gift temporary and past away
- (1) Let first miracle in evidence. Acts 2:43. This has common; then rarely miracle
  - (2) Was not possessed by the second generation X<sup>7</sup>. Heb. 2:3, 4  
of mountains
  - (3) The church built upon foundation of apostles and prophets. Eph. 2:20.  
They were accredited by signs, wonders, miracles. After the  
foundation laid, this ceased. No more apostles. How prophetic.  
This. No man raised for authentication. The Bible implied. One  
offered to the inspired word.
  - (4) No one person all the gifts. No one has all the gifts?  
I worry X<sup>7</sup> does it have all the gifts then it would be  
true that every generation does it have all the gifts.

Miracles today.

They lie in the sovereign purpose, but through history, periodically, interesting activity, relations, democracy. 7 days of Egypt - on day following Malachi. The gift of miracle always to go, coming again - resurrection
