THE GIFT OF SPEAKING IN TONGUES

I THE FACTS

(1) TV program, under "Project": "Just the facts, Ma'am. Just the facts."

1. Pentecost Acts 2:1-4, 5-11
Three miracles: sound of wind (type) eleven tongues / fire (type) languages
Understood languages, not unknown tongues. No interpreter necessary.

2. A phenomenon in Acts 10:44-46; Acts 19:1-6
(1) Caesarea. What was it there? Roman soldiers household - Latin, Greek, Jews, Greeks. In ecstasy, with amazement, address, the very biological phenomenon / reacting to the miracle tongues. Praying that in another tongue.

Never mentioned in any of the churches in areas of (Rome, Galatia, Asia, Macedonia).
Only in the church in U.S. Paul called them I Cor. 3:1-3 "born" "learned"
The gift of tongues not nearly so prominent in early church as the other
