THE GIFTS OF GOD

The Thessalonian church much persecuted, afflicted. They had to stay. Paul left.

On the outside - political, economic, social condemnation.
On the inside, as though not trouble enough, self-hated teachers
with favored people going, getting Paul as ready specimen after from him,
that the dark day of tribulation and worse (2:2). (what a tragedy -
this: the blessed, bright hope, need to stand the test, doubt, ?
in saints. Pottery, the extreme power of men.)
Confused, misled, some had turned from word (3:6, 10-12).
Supplied with malignant rumors, apparently, ceased from service,
thinking it vain to go on ...

IN ANSWER:

they are to work. We ought to do our work better - perhaps the

The dark days of tribulation, revolution, ? the antichrist, are coming
(though they were not in those then), and this leads to the sublime
prayer, Paul in this behalf. (2:17, 14, 16, 17)

1. The address

"our God from of himself, and not, now our Father..."
