The Christian's Triumph

So many things make our hearts tremble, from the fear of the Lord, but the presence of God in it all is a better thing for us.

(A) Three Permissives Events of God in the Beginning

I. The Fall of Satan

- (1) Gen. 1: 1, 2 = the construction of earth's universe.
- (2) Gen. 2: 1 = the new heavens and the new earth

II. The Fall of Adam

- (1) Gen. 3: 1 = Outside the gate, Satan, this sinister thing
- (2) Heb. 1: 14 = that we do stand above the angels. They minister, spirit
- Rom. 8: 12 = spirit - given with Christ

III. Death

- (1) Gen. 3: 22, 23, 24 = took away tree of life, did live forever
- (2) I Cor. 15: 50 = did be conformed in this world of death forever.
- 1 Cor. 9: 6 = but in this day shall we see death and resurrection
- (3) to die is a merciful provision: E.W. Robinson teaches so.
