# The Kinsman-Redeemer

2:3 "under whose wing ..."

[seems about. Had purpose in going to wing, the description]  
 [revelates how: eat, salt, money, keep it very close & it]  
 : in tolerance, as with the money seed  
 : intention in carrying it, close, well. Come in; no  
 confidence to those who shelter here. Come Ruth, from stable  
 : Ps. 17:4; 61:4; 63:7; 91:4; "Lift up thy wings"

2:17 gleaning in the right field, 2:8, how much received!

"owner" a day's supply of manna. Seed for 7 or 8 days. So  
 Ruth 10 days supply. Manna's instruction: 2:19 Manna  
 change from 1:13 to 2:20, and, but.

3:1 "shall I not see seed for thee?"

She meant Deut. 25:5-10.  
 So the instructions 8:2-5; and the meaning, 3:9, "for thee  
 art a new-kinsman" then art the one who has the right to redeem.

The word used may have in this little, short but:  $\text{קָנָה}$   
 participle,  $\text{קָנָה}$ , translated "redeem", "kinsman".

The word used in Job 19:25

Israel thought they a redeemer people Num. 3:44-51

The meaning of  $\{ \text{N} \}$ , "to deliver" to redeem <sup>44 by</sup> <sub>1000</sub>

1. To restore forfeited inheritance, property, land. Lev. 25:23-25
2. To gain a word. Only the name is same in both as the word. Lev. 25:47-49
3. To bring to rest by death, then clots into the name in the name of God, the rest, his to raise up seed, children to the dead. Gen. 25:5, 6-10.

This Judah's second son refused to do Gen. 38:6-10 Onan refused because the child to be born would not be his but his father's

A remarkable feature of the law, which provides for the benefit of the orphaned, maimed, "blind" & "deaf" - "redeem":  
 Name's family deal - the inheritance sold to another. In Gen the same code for the dead, restoration, identical w. Gen stands for redemption - resurrection.

3:9 Ruth manifested her unlimited trust in him that he would fulfill the obligation, a God. She ventured all upon his faithfulness to the duties imposed, 7th.
