Mother, indifferent, pass it by  
(a) Steeplechase "when you come to Zelzeth"

2. The love, prayers, poor people  
For your friends, by accident,  
For you, the church, society, educational program

3. The prepared home in Heaven

(a) mostly, regardless of - but you need to be set for this  
to my right, covers two bad places  
Don't you wish to be saved?

Mark 4: 3 - 20

- ① 4:4 wind takes away,  
seed never rise  
Heavens? seas of life then fit to lobed places  
(a) Big rocks makes stony ground, stone  
(b) stones, thistles, weeds, thorns, thistle  
Takes to her soft places,  
soil is all.  
The winds scatter away. Vain  
on earth.
- ② 4:5 "stony ground"  
Rocky bank
- ③ 4:7 "choked"  
The word dies out  
almost persuaded - Rich man rules over it v. 17 v. 20 Matt 16:3  
- Hand crippled
- ④ 4:8 good ground - seed increased  
{ running (S. B. T.) into some broken, rocky, thin soil confused  
ground in which grows well, others kept down in broken  
soil, 100% good soil. Cf. S. B. T., Degree 80. 120 - 134
