The power of any life lies in its expectation. What do you hope for?  
An explanation of the secret power of the early church: "Y is coming"  
This greeting: οὐαὶ ἀδελφοῖς τοῖς ἀπόστολοῖς "the 2nd coming"  
I Cor. 16: 22

Never forget: instantly watched: servants of the parallel  
at Mat. 24: v2-51, their assignment, to watch, wait.

Sometimes, as though looked for Christ immediately -  
opening sky, descending glorified. I Cor. 1: 23-31

as though the great consummation was future

II Tim. 2: 2

II Thess. 2: 2, 3

But whatever the form assumed, always filled with <sup>the</sup> God  
Power also, mainly to encourage by his

Paul full of "therefore" conclusion drawn from divine truth.  
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y. I Cor 15:58 chapter closing word. But cf Tim. 3:17; 4:1  
In his Phil 3:21:8:1  
Conclusion separate from argument.

Break up titles of Lord.  
"dearly beloved" Don't always cross.  
"dearly beloved" most dearest ones

"my dog and horses" Greek word for crown of laurel leaves.  
Paul's own title crown - they count.  
Hearns, & have to adapt them to see Jesus.  
Time was when Paul / Jesus called them hostile dogs.

no place, time, for passing. Not in keeping

4. 4:4  
"Rejoice in the Lord" "always" "again"  
not just Christians, entire. Always.  
Let the devotees of Baal sit themselves with laurels, smooth,  
with diamonds on them. But the servant of Christ is color,  
graceful assurance. If you, anoint head, wear face...  
His heart like a well-tuned harp, all its strings in order.  
"Glad tidings of great joy" the oil of gladness. Therefore.
