YUTTN - grief, sorrow. Sh. 22: v5; Jn. 16: 6  
YUT&W - to grieve, to aggrieve Mk. 10: 23; Jn. 11: 17

I. The Personality of the H.S. - as a loving person, can be grieved.

II. The attributes of the H.S. expressed in his work, that would lay him open to grief.

1. Loved us from the beginning. Bridges are to Jesus.

Without love, no grief.

As a child: quickened our hearts. Made sensitive to God  
: tries my own conscience. Works not to bind

one finger, praising hand to touch the Sabbath seal, many.

If resist: the place of the scripture "I will not the Spirit"
