Rap Music That Guns

SUMMARY: Amid growing drug-related violence, some rap musicians have been writing songs about crime from the perpetrator's view and posing with weapons for album covers. Critics say such actions are irresponsible and promote violence. Musicians call such views unfair and say their work just reflects the reality their audience can relate to.
