II. Joshua and Moses

1. First appearance Rephaim ("the giants")
camping site before reaching Sinai)
Moses struck rock for water Ex. 17:1-7
battle with Amalekites Ex. 17:8-16

This young captain, Joshua
in the wilderness certainly met a scary man
- stone
- beast
- men

Some of the Israelites with
disillusioned
complaining
word (long) for help, good
but Joshua committed.

2. Second appearance

accompanied Moses into the mountain
Ex. 24:13-18

Aaron, his two sons (Nahab, Abihu)
Seventy Elders, left behind. Into the glory days

Coming down, Moses: Joshua "war" (soldier)
: Moses "servant"

Joshua consecration & Joshua
devotion

3. Third appearance
Ex. 33:11

Moses to the top of the mountain to receive the
new table, stone.

No longer Aaron (complaint, complaint,
accidentally)

treated with the gift. Joshua

Joshua treacherously
trust

Moses sends for the 70 elders

All but two respond: Eldad, Medad.

Joshua reacted as a soldier: *in subordination
distinction not
