An Introduction to the Pastoral Epistles

The different words we enter from I, II Thess. to I Tim., Titus
I, II Thess. first letters
I, II Pet. Titus is last

The style of writing, content, purpose are different.

The end of the way: "Pastoral Epistles - not to Timothy, Titus
as friends simply, nor as individual & the simply, but as
pastors of the church, their Jesus. Indicating their minister is
the proper methods of pastoral work. Stated in I Pet. 3:14, 15
So, instructions, warnings, rebuke, etc.

- (1) False doctrine
e.g. II Tim. 2:17, 18 Hypocrisies, abilities - spiritualized
the resurrection (when some do not resurrect even know); or
death soul enters eternal state - that is all - body not there.
- (2) Church organization, work, ministry.

Written after the close of A.D.
Written after the close of A.D., while alone, freely, writing.
Paul is prison in Rome, his home, freely, writing.
But then wrote cannot be filled up freely within that period
of A.D. Here, also, II Pet. goes death. So, liberated, the time
of writing mentioned in Act. Cret, Nicopolis.

Woodrow Wilson
