Romans 9, 10, 11 a discussion of Israel

Romans 11: 25-29 Paul speaks of the

Impossible to resist the words to

is the present Jewish people and the
future believing Israel is the present church.

According to both the O.T. and the N.T
Scriptures the tribes of Israel have

I. For the Tribulation

Rev. 7-19 describes the Tribulation

Rev. 7 is a parenthesis between the 4th and 5th seals judgments.

There are presented two large groups of people who are the saved during that awful period, known in the O.T. as the time of Jacob's trouble 1 Jer. 30:7.

The first group: Rev. 7:4-8 are named the tribes of believing Israel, the sealed Jews who have come to faith in Christ during the Tribulation.

Rev. 14:4 describes them as "the first-fruits of those who have come to faith in Christ during the Tribulation before the second coming of Christ, whom Israel as a people and as a nation receive for son and heir."

The second group: Rev. 7:9-14 describe the believers of non-Jewish race, "of all nations, and kindreds, and tongues."

Exh. 48 (the last chapter) describes the
boundaries of the 12 tribes in their
home-land of Israel. Between the
territories of Judah and Benjamin
in the center of the land is the Holy
land area (48:8-20) $8\frac{1}{2}$ miles
long or $6\frac{2}{3}$ miles wide.
