Not to love of God, the love of man and woman.
mostly regards upon the family - majority of the love

Alabaster for his son Isaac - Gen. 25

The four conditions of a blessed home, marriage

(1) 29: 18 Supreme affection.
Some money for a wife - for respects - for money, arrangement,
to escape ceremonial uncleanness, & right another person

(2) 28: 1, 2; 29: 15, 17 Good-will of parents, friends.

(3) 29: 18 Recognition / a husband, willingness to submit to it
any one as own slave / gallantry - a true man to serve for 7 yrs!

(4) 28: 3, 4 "Only in the land"
