II The word Do Ποιειν

Acts 10:38 "Jesus went about doing good"  
John 14:12 "the work I do... ye do... by ye also"  
Phil. 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me"

1. Bringing out work to Jesus  
city... mission around the world

2. Our stewardship program  
working for me (pay bills), but also working for him (a target, plan)  
a part of me brought to church, give of 1 day, 10% - 12% day regularly, we worked 16

3. Nov. 10.70 the assembly, organized together  
- children & teens  
- My job to inspire  
- sensitive to guests, bring out, the best  
- my own work, help

III. Apart From X, Our Unableness, Inability, Incompetence

1. "without me" - a terrible, tragic thought  
a. by without X

(1) Come to the point without X  
intellectual, refinement, claims  
a message as well fitted for a message as a church  
secular assembly ...

"... S.S. class without X  
adjust to work, necessity, & the church without X  
we can do nothing apart from X - produce nothing  
not able in ourselves - bring forth -

(2) We, however, will only survive  
X in the pulpit, S.S. rooms, press, aisles, sermons, songs, ...  
Our absolute loss, in Galilee Tax case, Generalship  
His presence in the power of the U.S. The government is negotiating but  
of the strength is in the hand, not in the weapon ...
