In Due Season Arrives At The Day of His Suffering

- 1. Heb. 10:4, 5, 7  
standing before the people day in a year  
Heb. 12:50-77 saw a better... straited...  
John 12:27 (5 weeks) man soul to be shed...  
Matt 26:53, 54 I feel as man... 19 legs...  
Heb. 22:12-14 sweat - drops, blood

Heb 53:10, 18 toward of his soul

(1) Hebrews 10:4, 5, 7  
word, death, depart, rejoice, sorrow, tears  
(2) Corp. usually Heb 1:6 John's way, price  
now: world, born free, worn down, night march, robe

(3) Face brighten, eyes (no need for any man -)  
now: spot on, flushed heart, straight into?  
Heb 52:14 The sweat...?

(4) Thrown in prison  
now: The way, must work now learned  
around, inspired. Did miraculously. Saw help.

II The TERELOS of his suffering: purpose & achievement  
 His suffering fulfilled a purpose & achievement

1. Identity with us.

Heb. 2:11-13

The common denominator of all life: sorrow, tears, suffer  
 in tears! child born a real or mistery  
 ... .. near death  
 ... .. set of death

(1) Sorrow, believe to be well (the)

Heb. 5:6

Job 1:21 2:10

Job 1:21 2:10 "as my -- not did it?"

(2) Sympathy

Heb. 4:15, 16

Had to come, at least, bright, shining, asphy. ... .. we not  
 But he, man, Jesus, below (all the way, last, cost not, dying  
 ... .. "house of animals"

2. Sorrow us from fear, death

2:9, 15

a double fear "intentionally shared by all animal kingdom  
 (2) spiritually. "lost ahead", "fear?"

Death, now we enter "heaven" & live again in "heaven"

Satan's fear (evil, wrong)

(2) a demon - evil, blind man, hear his fear, think  
 that he is Christian in my prayer: before, not 4:13,  
 now, "I believe in you"

Rev 21 - "I am ..."

3. Being may move to go

Heb. 2:10

He leads, captain  
 a company of soldiers to "lead" a "great"

an army of "great" & "captain"  
 an "object" to "lead" & "lead"

70 Eph 4:9 Roman "troop"; soldier "lead" to "lead"  
 lead the "soldier", "soldier", "lead", "lead"...

(4) the "soldier". "lead".

The New Testament Use of the word  
"PERFECT"

ΤΕΛΕΙΟΣ - "perfect" *adjective.*

(1) full grown, of full age

Heb. 5:13, 14 "For every one that useth  
milk is unskillful in the word of  
righteousness: for he is a babe. But  
strong meat belongeth to them that  
are ΤΕΛΕΙΟΣ - of full age (AV)  
- full grown, mature

(2) complete in all its parts, "lacking nothing"

John 1:4 Let patience have her  
ΤΕΛΕΙΟΣ perfect work, that ye may be ΤΕΛΕΙΟΣ  
and entire, wanting nothing"

ΤΕΛΕΙΩΩ - to perfect, make perfect verb

(1) to complete, to finish

John 4:34 Jesus said unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to ΤΕΛΕΙΩΩ to finish (AV) his work.

(2) to accomplish, to fulfill

John 19:28 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now ΤΕΛΕΙΩΩ accomplished (AV), that the scripture might be ΤΕΛΕΙΩΩ fulfilled (AV) saith, I thirst.

ΤΕΛΕΙΟΤΗΣ  
ΤΕΛΕΙΩΤΗΣ } perfection, completion *noun*  
ΤΕΛΕΙΩΣΙΣ }

Col. 3:14 And above all these things,  
put on charity which is the bond of  
ΤΕΛΕΙΟΤΗΣ *perfection* (AV).

Heb. 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the  
author and ΤΕΛΕΙΩΤΗΣ *finisher* (AV)  
of our faith

ΤΕΛΕΙΩΣ - perfectly *adous*

I Peter 1:13 therefore gird up  
the loins of your mind, be sober,  
and hope ΤΕΛΕΙΩΣ to the end (AV)  
for the grace that is to be brought  
unto you at the revelation of  
Jesus Christ.
