On the decline of the church "THE CATHOLIC STORY" OF 1976

"Problems presented themselves by the arrival of ethnic minorities in the 1960's. These were largely blacks and Mexicans. A survey of the Hispanic population was attempted but there was no effective follow-up. The population remained unreached.

The church is also faced with a growing Asian community.

In short, the church that was formed in East Dallas ^{AND} that developed into one of the largest churches in the So. By. Cms.,

suddenly found itself in the middle of a mine field with the added complications of its multi-racial or cross-cultural character.

The response of Pastor to the new challenge could have been anticipated:
