Witnesses to the Gospel (The Prophecy & the Prophecy)

I. The Prophecy . 1: 10-12a

There is no new revelation.
 The same gospel the apostles preached, delivered beforehand by the prophets -
 A change in the message, no change in the message. ^{Paul - Paul}

 the evangelists looked back. Their eyes meet in one place, in power & glory.
 "the suffering" .. the glory. "the gospel"

A true witness of the early Xth to call the 4 narratives the 4 gospels?
 The voice, message, & the witness. He himself is the gospel?
 Jesus is the witness - a gospel? Any day, witness, life in presence of
 miracles? Christ - the awareness of mystery, divine, pain, death
 Jesus of Nazareth - 7 divine mysteries before the eyes of men.
 Jesus, apostle - for his friends, disciples - for ourselves, his disciples
 with Jesus, human limitation.
 The suffering, death & Christ - a gospel of our salvation. One witness upon this,
 1mo 3: 10 his small suffering the soul & his suffering.
 The glory that followed - a gospel, an ultimate revelation, joy triumph.

"Suffering" .. "glory" a veritable gospel, Jesus news from heaven with
 definite hope.
 Christ died for our sins - according to the scriptures (the prophets)
 "Saw down on night" .. "The glory" .. The glory. The world, our human nature
 to be there, and we with Christ. He had over all "all authority" .. whether
 recognized now or not. Not by popular election but by divine right.
 His power is constant, is immovably asserted. Verified in his
 countless millions through the ages. The power, Christ is still with us
 to give authority to our message. Miracles, years of our mission
 Some day Phil. 2: 10, 11 by command continue

II. The Apostles 1:12b

The prophets had seen in prophetic visions the great salvation & were though by suffering, they were. These prophets had seen & now were in the power, & that spirit by the apostles.

Everywhere preaching the word, dressed in no robe and they, going, possessing no distinctions but that, shame and suffering, no power but out of the day that. Fearlessly taking up their cross as a martyr's nation, going toiling in peaceful homes. They were joyful in the very unity, the presence of men in the spiritual unity, unity with the common bond. Then to a far away Parthians, Syria, etc., all the barbarians of the great salvation.

III. The Holy Spirit 1:12c

He was the Holy Spirit who speaks through the prophet
 - - - - - internal through Christ, raising them to the dead.
 - - - - - repeats the gospel through the apostles
 - - - - - who bears witness to the truth.

The gospel can never be revealed in its fullness unless it is preached in the power of the Holy Spirit. I, man, will not be seen the gospel must be preached with it. But that is not enough. We may preach the gospel clearly and to power. But that will bring no fruit, no power, the Spirit. Grant from the presence of the H.S. is present in us. Depend on you the H.S. - no over God, baptizes first, a dove...
 - - - - - the apostles. wait in Jerusalem
 - - - - - in the apostles, the greatest reward, "to fulfill with the Spirit"

f. a gospel readily conceived, warmly expressed, received with power, less thought or eyes been used, but into salvation which had intellectual discernment, study had failed, this is of divine power. It is not the power of the Holy Spirit, the power of the Holy Spirit - to power & say it. The presence moves the Holy Spirit in the power and in love, as they. Come Holy Spirit, clearly clear with all thy quickening power. Kindle a flame of power here in our cold hearts, O Lord.

IV The Angels 1:12c.

The prophets, beholding in wonder
The quaters, hearing in awe, breathless astonishment
The Holy Spirit in power, uniting, fire ...
The text says, the angels descending ...
