THE PERSONALITY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The scriptures in fact present God as a person, conversing, fellowshiping, working, visiting with men.

Ex. 33:11 And Jehovah spoke unto Moses face to face as a man speaketh... of. Gen. 3:8b

Jh. 24:50.53 and ye shall bless them... and they worshipped him... Acts 15:28 "to the Holy Spirit and to us..."

What an amazing fact: both together, thinking, deliberating, deciding... one is God the Holy Spirit the other is man made of dust.

There is no question but that the Bible presents the deity of the H.S. Matt 28:19 singular name. The full name, deity is Father, Son, H.S. The Trinitarian God. II Cor. 13:14 equals One in essence, being, attributes, grace, glory

Whatever can be said of God, can be said of the H.S. eternal Heb. 9:14 omnipotent Gen 1:2 omnipresent I Cor. 2:10, 11 knows all that God knows omnipresent Ps. 139:7-10

Articles of the English Church:

1 The Holy Ghost proceeding from the Father and the Son, is of one substance, majesty, and glory, with the Father and the Son, very and eternal God.

Westminster Confession of Faith:

4 In the unity of the Godhead there be three persons of one substance, power and eternity; God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost. The Father is of none, neither begotten nor proceeding; the Son is eternally begotten of the Father; the Holy Ghost eternally proceeding from the Father and the Son.
