Precious Spirit Gifts for The Church

Endowments of the Holy Spirit that make persons  
and sweet, noble and lovely, the work of the church.  
The members like the Saviors - Matt 20: 28 not to be ministered unto...  
- John 13: 14 "for you have served me..."  
because God has blessed the corporation.

To each according to need

1. I Cor. 12: 8 ἀρωτήσις προφητείας

The first of the 9 gifts is I Cor. 12: 8-10  
Has to do with God's plan, purpose for his church, his people. The spiritual  
principles of government, the deep spiritual truths in the body of Christ. What  
is in the wisdom of God.  
cf. I Cor. 12: 32 "the children of God have never been what they had  
understanding of it times, to know what great ought to do."  
cf. Acts 5: 34-40 Herod said "if you can't say; if you say, fight against."

Act 6: 1-7 qualification, discernment  
Act 6: 9, 10 Stephen, not able to withstand the wisdom by acting like angels  
Act 11: 1-18 Peter before the church, covering his foolish corollaries  
Act 15: 13-22 James (bro. Peter) covering judgments

2. I Cor. 12: 8 ἀρωτήσις γνώσεως

The second of the 9 gift  
understanding, appraisal, judgment, grasping the truth of things as they are  
the present situation, seeing, knowing as the W.S. sees, now.

cf. D.K. 6: 8-12 Eliakim... worked... in rotunda?

cf. Matt. 16: 17 Peter... fled and fled and concealed...

cf. John 4: 16-18, 29 Jesus and Samaritan woman

ἴλαπος - γόνος, cheerful, ἴλαπότητι - cheerfulness

a divine gift in God 1 Thes. 6:3:8; 1 Cor. 10:13; 1 Thes. 13:14  
Our sympathy for each other "Bless in us the Lord" Strong #3.

2. Rom. 12:8 ὁ παρακαλέων ἐν τῇ παρακλήσει

παρακαλέω - call alongside, to comfort, to encourage  
παρακλήσις - consolation, comfort, encouragement

used as a title for Christ I Cor 2:1 "Savior"

to U.S. soldiers 14:16, 26

For the members of Christ body, encouragement, strength

3. Rom. 12:8 ὁ μεταδίδούς ἐν ἀπάθετῃ

μεταδίδωμι - to share with, to impart

επιπλόησις - simplicity, vicinity, vicinity

a material vicinity, manifested in love / Christ  
not by sentiment, emotion, but by the W. S.  
(but in God's provision + His blessing)

Could it be - the gift of mercy money in order to support this work?
