1. The astounding thing to Jesus Mt. 12:41 Lk. 11:32

The results of the revival, greatest in the history of religion.  
One person - the entire city brought to God.  
Next to it in magnitude, Pentecost, 3000.  
But how? How many?  
"120,000 children: 600,000 people."  
"Three days journey" a cluster of cities. highly populated, with all around. A gathering of population around each.

2. The astounding thing to us, today.  
The wickedness of the city... of Sodom, Ammon, "came up to God" 1:8  
The repentance... "scorning it."

Repentance in the face of a great disaster.  
(2) Titani, "invisibly" "decided" "turn to God to this."  
But how, repentance upon no words preaching. 3:5-9

3. Revival is always astonishing.  
(a) had to father ~~Would have thought Jonah about all over that country. But no -~~  
(b) the city was ~~plague~~  
(c) football was ~~plague~~  
(d) no action parts. ~~None saved. Another no disaster~~  
Would have thought Jonah had started all over Gods creation

- The outlier, bitterly complaining prophet.
    - (1) His repentance as a prophet was at stake.  
Threatening turned out to be threats without effect. Bad reality.  
He had made a fool of himself. [If God, "a fool for 24 hrs"]
    - (2) He was angry with God.  
That God might be so deceived.  
May be joy in heaven over this sinner hit out Jonah. Is possible to  
delighting of the city with a vengeance. Delighted? ~~Delighted!~~  
The city. The city.
- The complaint is: a "just as I thought!"



(a) Harkins. Brown Rio Grande Valley 2/67  
The people at the front responding.  
Who are these people?
