Lady Jane Grey

a devout, pure woman
a devout, pure woman child
a devout, read Scripture in original language
King Edward VI, Protestant, chose her for his
successor.

Ten days later, Bloody Mary Tudor, Catholic,
proclaimed queen.

Had Lady Jane Grey (Queen Jane Grey)
lived (she was seventeen).

Three days before her execution, Feb 13, 1554
she said:

"I ground my faith on God's
word, and not upon the church.
If the church be a good church,
the faith of the church must be
tasted by God's word, not God's
word by the church."

Cyprian: "He who has not the church
for his mother has not God for his
father."

Augustine: "I would not believe the
scripture unless the authority of
the church confirms it."

Durkheim: "Man's nature is not
an organized lie, but human
consciousness has been warped
by sin."
