A woman whose name has been forgotten,
gave a tract one day to a very bad man,
Richard Baxter, ^{d. 1691. One of greatest of Eng. theologians.} who read it and was
converted. Then Baxter wrote a book,
"The Call of the Unconverted," which brought
a multitude to God among them, Philip
Doddridge, ^{d. 1751 English preacher, pastor. Wrote hymns: "O happy day..."} who in turn wrote a
book, "The Rise and Progress of Religion,"
which brought tens of thousands ^{into}
the kingdom, among them, ¹⁷⁸¹ Wilberforce. ^{d. 1833 slave trade statesman}
Wilberforce wrote, "A Practical view of
Christianity," ^{trans into many languages} which brought a
multitude to Christ, among them being
Leigh Richmond, ^{d. 1827 English pastor, editor, writer} who wrote a tract,
"The Dairyman's Daughter," which
has been the means of the conversion
of uncounted multitudes. So the
