The resurrection of Christ a sign of God.

1. Authenticated His ministry as being truly from God.
John 2:18 "what sign shewest thou us? ... 'Showing the temple'".
They replied at the cross Matt 27: 39, 40
"they rebuked him and said, 'we know that this man is the Christ,
for he saith, I am the Son of God'."

2. A declaration of His Deity
Rom. 1:4 "declare to be the Son of God .. by the resurrection from the dead"
"opposite marked out" (Anoige, the door was shut, loudly, swiftly, day)
(a) Napoleon I was ready to found a new religious party; "let yourself
convince, the third day rises from the dead, then we believe you."

3. An open avowal of our justification.
Rom 4:25 "delivered for us forever, raises again for our justification"
claiming us in heaven: "These are now who have placed this nation in me,
to present us faultless before God. Blood bought
Rom 5:10 "reconciles us; saves us etc"

4. A pledge of our own resurrection
I Cor. 6:14. II Cor. 4:14 "he who raises up the Lord Jesus shall raise up again."
I Thess. 4:13, 14 "For if we believe that Jesus died as our great example,
I Cor. 15:23 "Christ is first fruits, afterwards they will come forth in his company,
51-52 "... we shall all be changed..."
