I. The longing of Moses to go again

II Why denied?

Ex. 17:1-7 "smite" the rock

Num. 20:1-13 "speak" to the rock
(speak as small as offense)

1. The smitten rock the source of the rivers, waters,
just as the death of Christ must precede the descent of the Holy Spirit.
John 7:37-39
I Cor. 10:4

2. But needed only to be smitten once. On the
second occasion, Moses had to speak to it. Break the
type, the picture. For this disobedience, not allowed to enter.
