### THE SOUL AFTER DEATH

(The Intermediate State)

"I saw the souls . . . And they cried . . .  
Slain, dead, yet you see them, hear them speak.  
Not enough to say, just a vision. A vision, reality  
"Soul" always a body  
"spirit" with body  
body = a soul.  
but I'll leave that out.  
Their brief slumbers rest us and / them.  
Death makes them invisible to men in the flesh, but not invisible to God  
not just as he respects, prophetic wisdom

Scripturns always referring / mentioning consciousness of the soul in death  
Mt. 16: 19-26  
statement in OT despite numerous, chaotic words, death, & appearance

There is a life / the soul, an intermediate state, between  
death and the resurrection.

1. For the lost, the unbelieving

(a) a state of torment, of conscious suffering

Yh. 16: 22-24

(b) a prison, waiting for final trial then judgment, this world

I Peter 3: 19

D Peter 2: 4, 9 with my angle, but rendering more.

## 2. For the saved

In love entering into paradise

Heb. 2:3: v2, 4<sup>3</sup>

II Cor. 12:2 "caught up to the heaven"

And where is Paradise? 12:4 "in paradise"

Rev. 2:7 "that overcometh me, him I will give to sit on my throne"

22:2 "... tree of life" in life-giving

Many in heaven & earth have inheritance of golden crown, radiant  
garments & thrones, golden bowls, etc. ready to be distributed.

## 2. A being with the Lord of. about Heb. 2:3: v3 "with me"

II Cor. 5:8 "about from my body... great with the Lord"

Phil. 1: 20-24 "to depart... to be with Christ"

1:21 "gains" not to interfere with your becoming like  
Everything is going, not from greatness & honor, but from

not wandering, needlessly gazing

## Observations from the teaching of the Scriptures

1. No such thing as the soul sleeping between death and the resurrection  
when does speaking as sleep, refers to the body language, appearance  
(e.g. sun setting?)
2. No such thing as purgatory  
Besides, inconsistent with the completeness of Christ's atonement  
we are justified from faith alone Heb. 9:23, 28
3. Our mortal condition after death cannot be altered -  
it is fully, wholly determined in this life.  
Eccles. 11:3 "as it were fallen..."  
math. 25:10). "five foolish virgins"  
Rev. 16:26 "a great gulf fixed..."  
Rev. 22:11 "he that is upright let him be upright still"
