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stand that we are forgiven on the basis of Christ's shed blood. We are beyond the reach of judgment. Judicially, we are pardoned of all past, present and future sins. Our sins can never again be imputed to us, nor can we ever be accused of our sins again!

Willie Darden was accused of murdering a store owner and shooting two other people. The state of Florida tried Willie and, right or wrong, pronounced him guilty of murder in the first degree. On Tuesday, March 15th, 1988, Willie, who was called the Dean of death row, was executed in Florida's electric chair. He was also suspected by the authorities of committing six or seven other murders in the state. Let's suppose for a moment that new evidence now surfaces unquestionably linking him to the other murders. The additional evidence would be superfluous and meaningless because no other charges can ever be brought against old Willie. He has already paid the ultimate penalty—death!

On the spiritual side, the Law condemns us, declaring we are guilty sinners and must suffer the penalty of death. But, in God's rescue operation His precious Son died our death, bearing our punishment, which means no additional charges can ever be brought against the child of God!

THE RICHES OF HIS GRACE

". . . according to the riches of His grace" (Eph. 1:7).

God's plan of rescue was in accordance with the riches of His grace. Grace is far more than just God's "unmerited favor." Grace speaks of His delight to help His children. It's like the grandparents who can't wait for their grandchildren to visit. They're delighted to see those grandchildren and can't do
