Various reading in the ancient MSS. show how very ^{noted} sharply
from setting down such a word. I.g. many read now "the church
of the Lord -"

The great sacrifice which purchased the church is the sacrifice of God.

Now this declaration opens an old as long since dead and
buried heresy. 2nd 3rd centuries A.D., the church involved in long interminable
discussions regardj the person as well as Christology and otherwise.
one of the heresies which this trouble & more was called in the West,
orthodoxianism, in the East, Sabellianism. They believed that there were
but one divine essence, that the Father, Son, and Spirit were but three
manifestations of the one God - Sabellians used the illustration of the sun
with light, heat, & itself. This, of course identifies the Son with the
Father - they are the same - therefore the logical conclusion had to
follow. It was the faith taught [in the form of the Son (X)] ^{genuine and substantial} suffering on the cross. Hence
the name, Patripassianism.

The wrong thought that lay behind this heresy was this - that
X had no other humanity, that he was only a manifestation of God, that
he has no real life, personality, but by grant from God. Therefore, it was God
the Father who walked the earth, but the Father who agonized on Calvary,
suffered on the cross in the guise and substance, the Son.

That heresy was stamped out of the church. Yet it does as all
heresies do, like they never did hold the minds of men - a truth
to suggest. It is the truth which is repeated by the daring words of
Paul. not the God the Father died upon the cross
which as blood for us But that is the
whole sacrifice was X's the vicarious sacrifice was God the Father. If a
cross is a plain wooden Calvary, a cross is heavy also,
