# ALEXANDER THE GREAT

"All we know we learned from the Greeks"

Founder of western civilization.  
The most famous, and the most successful,  
of all military men. Never lost a battle.  
Son of Philip, King of Macedonia.  
at age 13, placed under instruction of  
Aristotle. Later took his teacher with him  
on all his campaigns.  
Upon death of Philip, 336 B.C. became  
king, not yet 20 years of age.

In 334 B.C. (23 years old) entered  
Asia with his Greek army of 35,000 men.  
Defeated Darius on his army of 600,000  
men at River Issus.

In 333 B.C. conquered rest of the world.  
his sister Ptolemy  
of story of Josephus - High priests gave guidance  
to meet him on way to Egypt. All <sup>of</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>world</sup>

In June, 323 B.C. died in Babylon  
in 37<sup>th</sup> year of his age.

# JULIUS CAESAR

One of most remarkable men who  
ever lived.

Born, Rome, July 12, 100 B.C.

60 B.C. the first Triumvirate: Pompey, Crassus, Caesar

Caesar vs. Brutus - Brutus between Pompey & Caesar.  
"the die is cast!" Pompey fled to Greece - to Egypt  
where assassinated.

In Egypt Caesar captivated by Cleopatra.  
Defeats the Parthians - wrote Roman Senate  
three words: VENI, VIDI, VICI.

Master of Roman world. Senate conferred  
title "IMPERATOR" for life. (intense one wife)

He was adopted nephew Octavian (Augustus)

In the Senate, 60 senators gathered Roman  
led by Brutus. Captured. Brutus to go  
was his, fell at feet, states Pompey  
44 B.C., 56<sup>th</sup> year of age.

## MARTIN LUTHER

Born Nov. 10, 1483 in EISELEBEN, center Germ.  
Father sent him to school to be a lawyer. But deeply  
influenced by religion (Catholic),

at Wartburg house from school near end of medieval  
day; friend killed by Luther; he struck to ground.

Entered monastery, Augustinian Order at ERFURT, 1505  
& rigorous life, vigils, fasts, flagellation...

In 1508, only 1 year after obtained a grant, called  
to teach at University of Wittenberg - target would die  
in 1546.

(a) Scala Santa, St. Peter's Lateran Church, Rome.  
Returns to Wittenberg, 1517 nailed 95 theses to  
door of the church (agit to establish church)  
The Reformation was on.

Translated Bible into German.

Wrote 37 hymns - "A mighty fortress" 37  
"EIN FESTE BURG"
