A. Who shall learn doctrine?

1. Those beyond the infant stage of Christianity.

1st Cor. 2:14

- Paul's of Corinth complains of his teachers 5: 12-14 "For when for the time of night to be teachers, ye have said that we teach you... and are become such as have said of milk, and not of strong meat. For ye ought that with milk ye should have been fed in the word of righteousness: for ye are babes. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, whom there is to be a reason of: and we have this service received to discuss both good and evil."

- Paul complaining to Titus 2: 1, 2 "I could not speak unto you but as unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat, for ye were not able to bear it."
